Sunday Tropar, tone 4: When the disciples of the Lord learned from the angel the glorious news of the resurrection* and cast off the ancestral condemnation,* they proudly told the apostles:* "Death has been plundered! Christ our God is risen* granting to the world great mercy."

Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, now and for ever and ever. Amen!

Kondak of Ñheese-fare Sunday, tone 6: Guide of wisdom, giver of understanding,* teacher of the ignorant and protector of the poor,* Master, strengthen my heart and make it understand.* You give me speech, word of the Father,* for I will not keep my lips from crying out to You.* Merciful Lord, have mercy on me a sinner.

Prokimen, tone 8: Pray and give praise to the Lord our God.

Verse: God is renowned in Judah, in Israel great is his name.

Epistle: A reading from the Letter of the Holy Apostle Paul to the Romans. (13:11 - 14:4)

Brothers and Sisters! Our salvation is closer than when we first accepted the faith. The night is far spent; the day draws near. Let us cast off deeds of darkness and put on the armor of light. Let us live honorably as in daylight; not in carousing and drunkenness, not in sexual excess and lust, not in quarreling and jealousy. Rather, put on the Lord Jesus Christ and make no provision for the desires of the flesh. Extend a kind welcome to those who are weak in faith. Do not enter in disputes with them. A man of sound faith knows he can eat anything, while one who is weak in faith eats only vegetables. The man who will eat anything must not ridicule him who abstains from certain foods; the man who abstains must not sit in judgment on him who eats. After all, God himself has made him welcome. Who are you to pass judgment on another's servant? His master alone can judge whether he stands or falls. And stand he will, for the Lord is able to make him stand.

Alleluia Verses: It is good to give praise to the Lord, and to sing to Your name, O Most High!
To announce Your mercy in the morning and Your truth every night.

Gospel: Matthew 6: 14 - 21

The Lord said: If you forgive the faults of others, your heavenly Father will forgive you yours. If you do not forgive others, neither will your Father forgive you. When you fast, you are not to look glum as the hypocrites do. They change the appearance of their faces so that others may see they are fasting. I assure you, they are already repaid. When you fast, see to it that you groom your hair and wash your face. In that way no one can see you are fasting but your Father who is hidden; and your Father who sees what is hidden will repay you. Do not lay up for yourselves an earthly treasure. Moths and rust corrode; thieves break in and steal. Make it your practice instead to store up heavenly treasure, which neither moths nor rust corrode nor thieves break in and steal. Remember, where your treasure is there your heart is also.

Regulations for Great Lent at

THE CANONS OF THE PARTICULAR LAW OF THE UKRAINIAN CATHOLIC CHURCH

- A strict fast is observed on the first day of the Great Fast and Passion Friday, i.e. abstention from meat and dairy products and eggs, as well as foods that contain these ingredients.
- Abstention from all meat and foods containing meat is to be observed during the **first week of the Great Fast and all days of Passion Week.**
- During the Great Fast, abstention from the consumption of meat and meat products is to be observed on all **Mondays, avoided Wednesdays and Fridays.** All other foods are permitted on Tuesdays and Thursdays.
- On all fast days and dispensed weeks the faithful are obliged to refrain from organizing and participating in loud parties, celebratory [e.g. wedding] receptions, dances, entertainment and other similar events.
- There is no fast on Saturdays, Sundays.
- **The following are dispensed from any obligation to fast:**
 1. *children up to 14 years of age;*
 2. *persons over 60 years of age;*
 3. *the gravely ill;*
 4. *pregnant women;*
 5. *postpartum mothers and those who are breast-feeding;*
 6. *those who are travelling (if the travel time exceeds eight hours);*
 7. *those engaged in heavy labour;*
 8. *those who eat from the table of others; the poor who live from charity;*
- In individual cases the local hierarch may grant a dispensation from the fast, in such an instance - exhorting the faithful to acts of piety and mercy.

What is Service of Forgiveness?

Service of Forgiveness is a beautiful service held in all Byzantine churches on the evening before Lent starts. The service emphasizes that God forgives our sins, but then also that we must forgive each other. At the service, the priest humbly asks the people in the church to forgive him if he has wronged them during the preceding year. The people reply by asking God to forgive the priest. Then the people ask the priest to forgive them if they have injured him, and the priest replies by asking that God forgive them. After these words, the people come forward, and the priest asks each individual member of the assembly for forgiveness. He gives each member a hug or a kiss. The people are admonished to ask each other individually for forgiveness for wrongs committed that year, and also to ask family members for forgiveness.

\$500 were sent to Bila Tserkva, near Kyiv to help one displaced Ukrainian Catholic family from Donetsk, who found shelter in Bila Tserkva. Their 12-year old daughter is suffering from cerebral palsy and autism. Rehabilitation is quite expensive, there is no available funds for these kids during the war.

Our life in this world flies so fast. That moment I noticed when again I stand here to celebrate the Sorokousty. Thousands of names that are completely unknown to me are on my lips and in my heart and mind, thousands of faces born in different parts of the world, those belonging to different continents, professions, churches of different ages, instantly flee from the memorial book, filling this temple. These names introduce us to the life of the deceased.



Who they are? Where they are? What's going on now? Why nobody don't give a sign about own existence? Maybe they disappeared at all? Maybe they got stuck in the mysterious labyrinths of the eternity? Why they don't warn us if we do something wrong?

With the moment of death, a person loses the opportunity to pray for himself. Only the living can pray for them who are now in eternity.

Church remembrance is a charity for the soul. According to the Fathers of the Church: The prayer for the deceased is considered to be the most humble request for those who are behind the margin of earthly existence. In Sorokousty prayer we do not experience any sensual satisfaction and we do not see the fruits of our requests.

Ephraim of Syria: The Church brings to us an important truth: the dead need prayers and they are very comforted when we bring them this alms of remembrance. Moreover, they themselves come to us for this prayer. During this remembrance we are entering into real communication with them. They are very grateful to us for this.

Remembering the fallen in Christ, we affirm that we have not forgotten about them, they remain an important part of our heart!

I as a priest I will celebrate the Sorokousty again soon, I realize that next year maybe someone else will stay here where I am now, and will lead this service. We all cannot be sure that we who are now praying for all deceased parishioners - in a year, will perhaps need this prayer as well, thankfully looking for Sorokousty service from above in eternity.

Basic Guidelines for Reception of Holy Communion

You are a member of the Catholic Church; You have participated in the Sacrament of Confession at least during the Easter or Christmas seasons this past year if not more frequently; You attend Divine Services regularly; Your lifestyle is consistent with the teaching of the Catholic Church; You have kept the Liturgical fast – no food at least one hour prior to the Divine Liturgy (water and medicine does not break the fast). You have been in church from the beginning of the service, or at least heard the Gospel. To the best of your ability, you are in the state of Grace. ***If for any of these or other reasons you cannot receive Holy Communion, you are welcome to come for a blessing. Please indicate to the priest that you would like to receive his blessing.*** For those who are divorced and living common-law the Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist cannot be received. You are welcome to come for a blessing. (If you are divorced with a Church annulment, and remarried in the Church you are more than welcome to receive the Holy Sacraments.)
