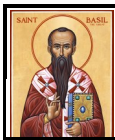

Sunday, Tropar, tone 5: Let us the faithful acclaim and worship the Word,* co-eternal with the Father and the Spirit,* and born of the Virgin for our salvation.* For He willed to be lifted up on the cross in the flesh,* to suffer death and to raise the dead* by His glorious resurrection.

Tropar, 1st Sunday of Lent, tone 2: We pay homage to Your undefiled image, Good Lord,* and beg pardon for our faults, Christ our God.* By Your will You chose to mount the cross in Your flesh* to free Your creatures from slavery to the enemy.* For this we gratefully cry out to You:* "By coming to save the world, our Saviour, You filled all things with joy."

Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, now and for ever and ever. Amen!

Kondak of the 1st Sunday of Lent, tone 8: The uncircumscribed Word of the Father* became circumscribed by being enfleshed from you, Godbearer.* You brought back the stained image to its original state* by infusing it with divine beauty.* But recognizing our salvation we portray it by word and deed.

Prokimen, tone 4: Blessed are you, and praiseworthy, O Lord, the God of our fathers, and glorious forever is your name.

Verse: For you are just in all you have done.

Epistle: A reading from the Epistle to the Hebrews. (11: 24 -26; 32 - 12: 2)

Brothers and Sisters! By faith Moses, when he had grown up, refused to be known as the son of Pharaoh's daughter; he wished to be ill-treated along with God's people rather than enjoy the fleeting rewards of sin. Moses considered the reproach borne by God's Anointed greater riches than the treasures of Egypt, for he was looking to the reward. What more shall I recount? I have no time to tell of Gideon, Barak, Samson, Jephthah, of David and Samuel and the prophets, who by faith conquered kingdoms, did what was just, obtained the promises; they broke the jaws of lions, put out raging fires, escaped the devouring sword; though weak they were made powerful, became strong in battle, and turned back foreign invaders. Women received back their dead through resurrection. Others were tortured and would not receive deliverance, in order to obtain a better resurrection. Still others endured mockery, scourging, even chains and imprisonment. They were stoned, sawed in two, put to death at sword's point; they went about garbed in the skins of sheep or goats, needy, afflicted, tormented. The world was not worthy of them. They wandered about in deserts and on mountains, they dwelt in caves and in holes of the earth. Yet despite the fact that all of these were approved because of their faith, they did not obtain what had been promised. God had made a better plan, a plan which included us. Without us, they were not to be made perfect. Therefore, since we for our part are surrounded by this cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every encumbrance of sin which clings to us and persevere in running the race which lies ahead. Let us keep our eyes fixed on Jesus, who inspires and perfects our faith.

Alleluia Verses: Moses and Aaron are among His priests and Samuel among those who call upon His name.

They called upon the Lord, and he answered them.

Gospel: John 1: 43 - 51

At that time Jesus set out for Galilee, but first he came upon Philip. "Follow me," Jesus said to him. Now Philip was from Bethsaida, the same town as Andrew and Peter. Philip sought out Nathanael and told him, "We have found the one Moses spoke of in the law -- the prophets too -- Jesus, son of Joseph, from Nazareth." Nathanael's response to that was, "Can anything good come from Nazareth?" and Philip replied, "Come, see for yourself." When Jesus saw Nathanael coming toward him, he remarked: "This man is a true Israelite. There is no guile in him." "How do you know me?" Nathanael asked him. "Before Philip called you," Jesus answered, "I saw you under the fig tree." "Rabbi," said Nathanael, "you are the Son of God; you are the king of Israel." Jesus responded: "Do you believe just because I told you I saw you under the fig tree? You will see much greater things than that." He went on to tell them, "I solemnly assure you, you shall see the sky opened and the angels of God ascending and descending on the Son of Man."

Прокімен, глас 4: Благословенний Ти, Господи, Боже батьків наших, і хвали достойний; ім'я Твоє преславне на всі віки.

Стих: Бо ти праведний у всьому, що вчинив єси нам.

Апостол: ДО Єврейв послання святого апостола Павла читання. (11: 24 - 26; 32 - 12:2)

Браття і Сестри! Вірою Мойсей, коли був виріс, відрікся зватися сином дочки фараона; волів радше страждати разом з людом Божим, ніж зазнавати дочасної гріховної втіхи, бо, дивлячись на нагороду, вважав за більше багатство наругу вибраного народу від скарбів Єгипту. І що ще скажу? Часу не вистане мені, коли почну розповідати про Гедеона, про Варака, про Самсона, про Єфту, про Давида й Самуїла та пророків, що вірою підбили царства, чинили справедливість, обітниць досягнули, загородили пащі левам, силу вогню гасили, вістря меча уникали, ставали сильні, буди недолугі, на війні проявили мужність, насюки чужинців відбивали. Жінки діставали своїх померлих, які воскресали. Інші загинули в муках, відкинувши визволення, щоб досягнути ліпше воскресіння. Інші наруг і бичів зазнали та ще й кайданів і в'язниці; їх каменовано, розрізувано пилою, брано на допити; вони вмирили, мечем забиті; тинялися в овечих та козячих шкурах, збідовані, гноблені, кривджені; вони, яких світ був невартий, блукали пустинями, горами, печерами та земними вертепами. І всі вони, дарма що мали добре засвідчення вірою, не одержали обіцяного, бо Бог зберіг нам щось краще, щоб вони не без нас досягли досконалості. Тому і ми, маючи навколо себе таку велику хмару свідків, відкиньмо всякий тягар і гріх, що так легко обмотує, і біжімо витривало до змагання, що призначене нам, вдвляючися пильно в Ісуса, засновника й завершителя віри.

Євангелія: Від Йоана 1: 43 - 51

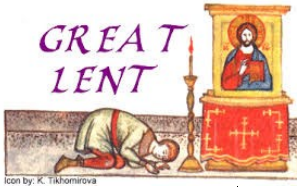

Regulations for Great Lent at

THE CANONS OF THE PARTICULAR LAW OF THE UKRAINIAN CATHOLIC CHURCH

- A strict fast is observed on the first day of the Great Fast and Passion Friday, i.e. abstention from meat and dairy products and eggs, as well as foods that contain these ingredients.
- Abstention from all meat and foods containing meat is to be observed during the **first week of the Great Fast and all days of Passion Week.**
- During the Great Fast, abstention from the consumption of meat and meat products is to be observed on all **Mondays, avoided Wednesdays and Fridays.** All other foods are permitted on Tuesdays and Thursdays.
- On all fast days and dispensed weeks the faithful are obliged to refrain from organizing and participating in loud parties, celebratory [e.g. wedding] receptions, dan6. those who are travelling (if the travel time exceeds eight hours);
- 7. those engaged in heavy labour;
- 8. those who eat from the table of others;
- the poor who live from charity;
- ces, entertainment and other similar events.
- There is no fast on Saturdays, Sundays.
- **The following are dispensed from any obligation to fast:**
 1. *children up to 14 years of age;*
 2. *persons over 60 years of age;*
 3. *the gravely ill;*
 4. *pregnant women;*
 5. *postpartum mothers and those who are breastfeeding;*
 6. *those who are travelling (if the travel time exceeds eight hours);*
 7. *those engaged in heavy labour;*
 8. *those who eat from the table of others; the poor who live from charity;*
- In individual cases the local hierarch may grant a dispensation from the fast, in such an instance - exhorting the faithful to acts of piety and mercy.

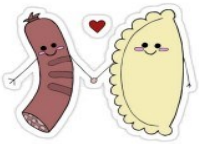

Liturgy of the Presanctified Gifts

As we already have seen, the eucharistic Divine Liturgy is not celebrated in the Eastern Church on lenten weekdays. In order for the faithful to sustain their lenten effort by participation in Holy Communion, the Liturgy of the Presanctified Gifts is served. The service is an ancient one in our Church. We officially hear about it in the canons of the seventh century, which obviously indicates its development at a much earlier date.

“On all days of the holy fast of Lent, except on the Sabbath, the Lord's Day, and the holy day of the Annunciation, the Liturgy of the Presanctified is to be served.” (Canon 52, Quinisext, 692) The Liturgy of the Presanctified Gifts is an evening service. It is the solemn Lenten Vespers with the administration of Holy Communion added to it. Due to circumstances we are celebrating this Liturgy in the morning. **There is no consecration of the eucharistic gifts at the presanctified liturgy. This is a important difference between Liturgy of St. John Chrysostom and Presanctified, especially when we offer an intention. According to the Canon Law priest can take free will offering and pray for the special request on Liturgy on Presanctified Gifts. Please always keep this in mind.**

Holy Communion is given from the eucharistic gifts sanctified on the previous Sunday at the celebration of the Divine Liturgy, unless, of course, the feast of the Annunciation should intervene; hence its name of 'presanctified.'"

The Liturgy of the Presanctified Gifts is served on Wednesday and Friday evenings, although some churches may celebrate it only on one of these days. It comes in the evening after a day of spiritual preparation and total abstinence. The faithful who are unable to make the effort of total fasting because of weakness or work, however, normally eat a light lenten meal in the early morning. During the psalms of Vespers, the presanctified gifts are prepared for communion. They are transferred from the altar table where they have been reserved since the Divine Liturgy, and are placed on the table of oblation.

The Liturgy of the Presanctified Gifts is traditionally considered to be the work of the sixth-century pope, Saint Gregory of Rome.

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FIRST SUNDAY OF LENT

Jesus calls Philip with the simple words "follow Me." Each of us is called in like manner in Baptism. Most of us were baptized as infants and others made the commitment for us. How or where were you first aware of the Lord's call in your own life and the need to make this commitment your own? Do you still feel that call? Or has the fire gone out? If the fire has gone out, what is the way to get "fired up" again?

Philip tells Nathanael about Jesus because his experience has so moved him. Does your experience of Jesus' call in your life cause you to tell others? Or do you think your experience is a private thing and it's just "what's done" so you keep it to yourself?

Philip says to Nathanael, "Come and see." This is the Church's approach. Does my preparation for and participation in the Church's liturgical life make me "see" better? If not, what do I need to do to enter more deeply into the Mystery of God working with His People in and through the Church?

Nathanael asks Jesus how He "knows" him. "Know" in Old English means "having an intimate relationship with." Do you have or want this kind of tight relationship with God? Does it scare you? Intimate relationships require work to keep them going. Do you work at yours with God or do you just "go along to get along"--letting it become something routine. Is Lent a time to get back on focus?

If the sky opened and you saw the sight Jesus describes what would you think would be your reaction? Would you react like the Biblical people and be in awe or would you remain the same? Many people can become jaded in our present world because it denies that there is something more here than meets the eye or can be directly experienced. Do you think people really hear this statement of Jesus or does it just slide off without making any impression on the hearers?

The Sunday of Orthodoxy calls us to examine our relationship with Christ. No only are we called to correct doctrine and correct worship, but we are called to get our own relationship with Christ and His Church on the right track. If we've strayed off course, now is the time to get it back on track again.

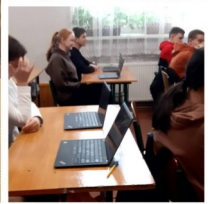

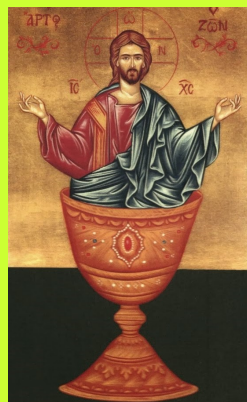

Basic Guidelines for Reception of Holy Communion

You are a member of the Catholic Church; You have participated in the Sacrament of Confession at least during the Easter or Christmas seasons this past year if not more frequently; You attend Divine Services regularly; Your lifestyle is consistent with the teaching of the Catholic Church; You have kept the Liturgical fast – no food at least one hour prior to the Divine Liturgy (water and medicine does not break the fast). You have been in church from the beginning of the service, or at least heard the Gospel. To the best of your ability, you are in the state of Grace. ***If for any of these or other reasons you cannot receive Holy Communion, you are welcome to come for a blessing. Please indicate to the priest that you would like to receive his blessing.*** For those who are divorced and living common-law the Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist cannot be received. You are welcome to come for a blessing. (If you are divorced with a Church annulment, and remarried in the Church you are more than welcome to receive the Holy Sacraments.)
