

4th Sunday after Pentecost

Tropar, tone 3: Let the heavens be glad, let the earth rejoice,* for the Lord has done a mighty deed with His arm.* He trampled death by death; He became the first born of the dead;* He saved us from the abyss of Hades* and granted great mercy to the world.

Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, now and for ever and ever. Amen.

Kondak, tone 3: You rose from the tomb, O compassionate Lord,* and led us out from the gates of death.* Today Adam exults and Eve rejoices,* and the prophets together with the patriarchs unceasingly acclaim* the divine might of Your power.

Prokimen, tone 3: Sing to our God, sing; sing to our King, sing.

Verse: Clap your hands, all you nations; shout unto God with the voice of joy.

Epistle: A reading from the Letter of the Holy Apostle Paul to the Romans. (6: 18 - 23)

Brothers & Sisters! Freed from your sin, you became slaves of justice. (I use the following example from human affairs because of your weak human nature.) Just as formerly you enslaved your bodies to impurity and licentiousness for their degradation, make them now the servants of justice for your sanctification. When you were slaves of sin, you had freedom from justice. What benefit did you then enjoy? Things you are now ashamed of, all of them tending toward death. But now that you are freed from sin and have become slaves of God, your benefit is sanctification as you tend toward eternal life. The wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Alleluia Verses: In You, O Lord, have I hoped that I may not be put to shame for ever.

Be a protector unto me, O God, and a house of refuge to save me.

Gospel: Matthew 8: 5 - 13

At that time as Jesus entered Capernaum, a centurion approached him with this request: "Sir, my serving boy is at home in bed paralyzed, suffering painfully." He said to him, "I will come and cure him." "Sir," the centurion said in reply, "I am not worthy to have you under my roof. Just give an order and my boy will get better. I am a man under authority myself and I have troops assigned to me. If I give one man the order, 'Dismissed,' off he goes. If I say to another, 'Come here,' he comes. If I tell my slave, 'Do this,' he does it." Jesus showed amazement on hearing this and remarked to his followers, "I assure you, I have never found this much faith in Israel. Mark what I say! Many will come from the east and the west and will find a place at the banquet in the kingdom of God with Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, while the natural heirs of the kingdom will be driven out into the dark. Wailing will be heard there, and the grinding of teeth." To the centurion Jesus said, "Go home. It shall be done because you trusted." That very moment the boy got better.

4th Sunday After Pentecost

What does it take to impress you? If you're older, it probably take quite a bit, doesn't it? You've seen quite a lot in your life, so to really impress you is kind of a tall order by now. But if you're younger, you don't have as much experience, haven't been around, still have a lot to learn. It might not take as much to impress you. I remember as a kid, going into snow for the first time. Wow! I can still remember crying, because it was snowing, and the cold snow was hitting my face and stinging my skin! My parents thought that was pretty funny of course. But, I'm sure I was impressed too, by it all. But now, snow is....snow! Things don't tend to impress as much do they? But every once in a while, there will be that scene in nature perhaps, a beautiful mountain, a breathtaking sunset, an amazing cloud formation, that makes you stop, and pause, and say "wow!"

For someone who has been around for a long time though, and has seen a lot of the world, it gets a little harder to impress them.

How hard do you think it is to impress God? Talk about someone who's been around a long time, and seen a lot!

But today, we heard about someone who got a "wow!" out of the Lord! Jesus Christ, being God, has pretty much seen it all. In fact, He created it all, right? What has He possibly not seen?

Well here, we have a centurion, a Roman soldier. A pagan. Not Jewish, certainly not Christian, at least not yet. Someone who has probably been around, though, himself. He's got a lot of experience in his position.

Well, this highly trained centurion had by now seen enough of Jesus Christ, to know that this Man is special. The Centurion has been paying attention, more closely than just about anyone else around there. In all of his experience, he has never seen anyone at all like Jesus Christ. And he's seen some things, seen a lot of fakers and charlatans. He's seen all the rabbis, the pharisees, and the sadducees. And in Christ, he saw the real thing, authenticity. He knew he could trust Jesus. This was a man to whom you really had to prove yourself to gain his trust.

Now he came to Jesus, and how did he talk to Him? What humility! The centurion pleads with Jesus for help for his servant. Pleads! A centurion! And the Lord right away answers, because in this centurion He saw something. He didn't beat around the bush, or test his faith like in other cases. He could see he was not Jewish, He could see he was a pagan. But this centurion, a careful observer, already knows that a mere word from the Lord is enough to help his servant. And there in front of everyone, the gentile, the pagan, the symbol of Roman authority, and oppression, expresses total, yet simple faith in the Lord.

Jesus offers to come straight to his house. The centurion stops Him, and again with such humility, says in verses 8 & 9: "Lord, I am not worthy that You should come under my roof. But only speak a word, and my servant will be healed. For I also am a man under authority, having soldiers under me. And I say to this one, 'Go,' and he goes; and to another, 'Come,' and he comes; and to my servant, 'Do this,' and he does it."

And this, brothers and sisters, is what makes the Lord say "Wow!" This expression of faith, truly impresses the Lord. In verse 10 of our Gospel it says: "When Jesus heard it, He marveled, and said to those who followed, 'Assuredly, I say to you, I have not found such great faith, not even in Israel!'"

The Lord, who knows all, sees all, says in this one Roman Centurion, He has seen something that He could not find in any of the "Chosen People"! He "marveled"! What a thing! Faith, is what impresses the Lord, Who has seen it all, truly seen it all.

Faith, brothers and sisters. Do we have the kind of faith that would impress the Lord? If we do not, don't be afraid, don't despair. Because the Lord tells us, a little earlier in the Gospel of Matthew chapter 7: "7 Ask, and it will be given to you! Seek, and you will find! Knock, and it will be opened for you! 8 Indeed, everyone who asks receives. Whoever seeks finds! To the one who knocks, it will be opened." (Mt 7:7-11).

Ask! And it will be given to you! In our lives, the Lord gives us many opportunities, to seek and to find. Today, we are given yet another one of those opportunities. Let us take the example of the Centurion, and respond to the Lord with faith. Open the door to our hearts, for He is there knocking gently. Let us hear Him, listen to Him!

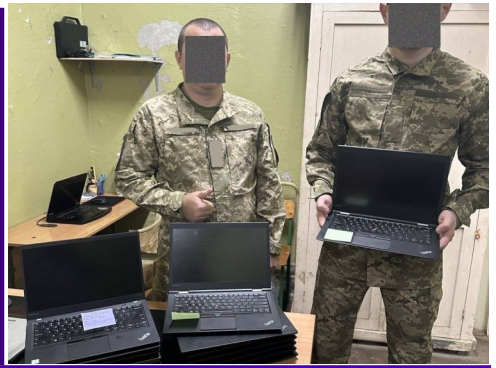

“The Country Needs Priests”: Oksana Zabuzhko in Foreword to His Beatitude Sviatoslav’s Book of Messages

“The country needs priests. This thought suddenly came to my mind when I was reading this book—in small portions, several sermons a day,” writes Oksana Zabuzhko in the foreword to the book of His Beatitude Sviatoslav’s daily addresses during the first year of the full-scale war, *Ukraine Stands! Ukraine Fights! Ukraine Prays!*

The writer noted that the church sermon is not a typical genre for her, but while reading this book, she engaged with it alongside the author.

“The term ‘sacrilegious war,’ often used by the author, is not accidental. It signifies not only the violation of God’s commandments (which are violated in every war, one way or another), but an attack on the very order of things granted by God, on the foundations of existence: a mockery of the Creator, not just the creature,” Ms. Zabuzhko observed.

In her opinion, the fact that the “Great War” unleashed by Russia against Ukraine is “godless” and therefore a war against God is clear to everyone—both believers and agnostics.

“‘The country needs priests’ (certainly ‘good’ ones!)—and this book is needed: as a one hundred percent credible replacement for all the volumes of motivational literature that have been dismissed and despised in one blow, like withered leaves. Because this, I emphasize once again, is not just a collection of video messages delivered by His Beatitude every day for a year, from February 25, 2022, to February 24, 2023. It is not just a memorial of the first year of the war (although as such, it is critical and should be on the shelves of our libraries as a document of both secular and church history). For the reader who is craving meaning and is ready to cooperate, it also has its own internal plot, its own ‘story’—the story of a priest who, before our eyes, is helped by faith to ‘wrestle’ and ‘handle’ what seems to be a human’s greatest challenge: to see the presence of God where children are being killed,” the writer noted in the foreword.

“Discussing Christian sins and virtues just after the atrocities of Bucha and Mariupol proves to be unexpectedly appropriate and relevant,” she admitted, “as an answer to the question of how one can (and should!) live on. The often repeated theme of ‘blessed are the peacemakers,’ according to the logic of the church calendar that is incomprehensible to me, gradually grows into a separate cross-cutting ‘sub-series’—a treatise on the meaning of peace.”

Oksana Zabuzhko called His Beatitude Sviatoslav’s book a practical guide that contains answers to the central questions in the context of the sacrilegious war: 1) where to find personal strength, and 2) how to rebuild Ukraine from the ruins of the “elaborate plan.” “Somewhere at this stage, I realized that ‘the country needs priests’: this is exactly the kind of leadership we need for the whole country. Without it, we ‘cannot handle,’ we have faced a very serious test... Therefore, I will conclude by paraphrasing J. P. Sartre: have patience to read this book,” the writer summarized.

Проповідь в четверту неділю після Зіслання Святого Духа

Коли у сім'ї народжується дитина, то батьки спочатку вчать немовля загальних речей: говорити перші слова, ходити, їсти тверді страви, а вже пізніше привчають до більш складніших речей. Щось подібне відбувається у житті Церкви у перші неділі після Зелених Свят.

Сьогодні переживаємо четверту неділю після Зіслання Святого Духа. Сходження Святого Духа на апостолів Отці Церкви називають днем народження Церкви, початком її самостійної діяльності. Тому у перші неділі після Зелених Свят, у перші дні свого існування Церква роздумує про основні свої завдання, про основи духовного життя її членів: святість, Євхаристію, покликання, Царство Небесне.

Кожної неділі на Святій Літургії читається уривок Євангелія і роздумуємо над якоюсь Божою правдою, темою духовного життя. У четверту неділю після Зіслання Святого Духа Церква переходить від загальних до окремих тем духовного життя, починаючи з питання віри – основи духовного життя. Завданням Євангельських читань кожної неділі є допомогти нам збудувати наш духовний дім – зв'язок з Богом. А що за будинок без фундаменту? Добрий будинок потребує міцного, надійного фундаменту. Саме таким надійним фундаментом нашого духовного дому є віра в Бога, віра в його любов, доброту і милосердя, справедливість.

Віра, це не тільки визнання існування Бога. Віра, це перший крок людини до Бога, перший крок духовного життя, особистого з'єднання з Богом, коли людина визнає існування Бога, старається Його пізнати і з Ним з'єднатися. Крок віри проявляється пізніше у житті християнина дотриманням Божих заповідей, в особистій молитві, практикуванні Святих Тайн, розважанні Божого Слова. Правдива віра, яка шукає зустрічі з Богом, переростає у молитву, у любов Бога, коли душа бачить Бога і любить Його в особі ближніх, як це вчинив римський сотник щодо свого хворого слуги.

Щоб виявляти любов ближнім, як самому Богові, треба вірити, що Бог є присутній в них і нагороджує за це взаємною любов'ю.

Четверта неділя після Зіслання Святого Духа називається також неділею всіх святих українського народу. Українські святі, це знак Божого благословення і опіки для нашого народу і держави, нашої землі. Це Божі знаки віри і любові для нас. Вони - наші провідники до Бога, до неба, заступники перед Богом у небі.

Українські святі різних часів, як Антоній і Теодосій Печерські, мученики Борис і Гліб, святий Йосафат, Андрей Шептицький, мученики 20 століття, це духовні пастирі українського народу, котрі, подібно як сотник, постійно дбали про добро нашого народу, постійно молили Бога за кращу і щасливу долю рідної України, а навіть віддавали своє життя за єдність нашої церкви, свободу і незалежність держави, за збереження серед народу правдивої віри і взаємної любові.

Отож, практикуймо набожність до українських святих, шануючи цим їх, як особливий Божий дар для нас. Просімо Господа за їх посередництвом, щоб ми вистояли в нашому правдивому християнському житті аж до смерті, любили щирим серцем нашу церкву і державу, так як вони.

To the best of your ability, you are in the state of Grace. ***If for any of these or other reasons you cannot receive Holy Communion, you are welcome to come for a blessing. Please indicate to the priest that you would like to receive his blessing. For those who are divorced and living common-law the Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist cannot be received. You are welcome to come for a blessing. (If you are divorced with a Church annulment, and remarried in the Church you are more than welcome to receive the Holy Sacraments.)***
