Sunday, August 3

8th Sunday after Pentecost

Tropar, tone 7: By Your cross You destroyed death;* You opened Paradise to the thief;* You changed the lamentation of the myrrh-bearers to joy,* and charged the apostles to proclaim* that You are risen, O Christ, our God,* offering great mercy to the world.

Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, now and for ever and ever. Amen. Kondak, tone 7: No longer shall the dominion of death be able to hold humanity,* for Christ went down shattering and destroying its powers.* Hades is bound.* The prophets exult with one voice.* The Savior has come for those with faith, saying:* "Come forth, O faithful, to the resurrection!" Prokimen, tone 7: The Lord will give strength to His people; the Lord will bless His people with peace.

Verse: Bring to the Lord, O you sons of God; bring to the Lord young rams.

Epistle: A reading from the First Letter of the Holy Apostle Paul to the Corinthians. (1: 10 - 18) Brothers and Sisters! I beg you in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, to agree in what you say. Let there be no factions; rather, be united in mind and judgment. I have been informed, my brothers, by certain members of Chloe's household that you are quarreling among yourselves. This is what I mean: One of you will say, "I belong to Paul," another, "I belong to Apollos," still another, "Cephas has my allegiance," and the fourth, "I belong to Christ." Has Christ, then, been divided into parts? Was it Paul who was crucified for you? Was it in Paul's name that you were baptized? Thank God I baptized none of you except Crispus and Gaius, so there are none who can say that you were baptized in my name. Oh, and I baptized the household of Stephanus. Beyond that, I am not aware of having baptized anyone else. For Christ did not send me to baptize, but to preach the gospel — not with wordy "wisdom," however, lest the cross of Christ be rendered void of its meaning. The message of the cross is complete absurdity to those who are headed for ruin, but to us who are experiencing salvation, it is the power of God.

Alleluia Verses: It is good to give praise to the Lord; and to sing in Your name, O Most High. To announce Your mercy in the morning and Your truth every night.

Gospel: Matthew 14: 14 - 22

At that time as Jesus saw the vast throng, his heart was moved with pity, and he cured their sick. As evening drew on, his disciples came to him with the suggestion: "This is a deserted place and it is already late. Dismiss the crowds so that they may go to the villages and buy some food for themselves." Jesus said to them: "There is no need for them to disperse. Give them something to eat yourselves." "We have nothing here," they replied, "but five loaves and a couple of fish." "Bring them here," he said. Then he ordered the crowds to sit down on the grass. He took the five loaves and two fish, looked up to heaven, blessed and broke them and gave the loaves to the disciples, who in turn gave them to the people. All those present ate their fill. The fragments remaining, when gathered up, filled twelve baskets. Those who ate were about five thousand, not counting women and children. Immediately afterward, while dismissing the crowds, Jesus insisted that his disciples get into the boat and precede him to the other side.

Благаю вас ім'ям Господа нашого Ісуса Христа, щоб ви всі те саме говорили; щоб не було розколів поміж вами, але щоб були поєднані в однім розумінні й у одній думці. Я бо довідався про вас, мої брати, від людей Хлої, що між вами є суперечки. Кажу ж про те, що кожен з вас говорить: "Я, Павлів; а я, Аполлосів; а я, Кифин; а я, Христів." Чи ж Христос розділився? Хіба Павло був розп'ятий за вас? Або хіба в Павлове ім'я ви христилися? Дякую Богові, що я нікого з вас не охристив, крім Криспа та Гая, щоб не сказав хтось, що ви були охрещені в моє ім'я. Охрестив я теж дім Степани; а більш не знаю, чи хрестив я когось іншого. Христос же послав мене не хрестити, а благовістити, і то не мудрістю слова, щоб хрест Христа не став безуспішним. Бо слово про хрест — глупота тим, що погибають, а для нас, що спасаємося, сила Божа.

Стихи на Алилуя: Добре воно прославляти Господа, і співати імені Твоєму, Всевишній. Звіщати вранці милість Твою, і ночами твою вірність.

Євангелія: Від Матея 14: 14 - 22

Того часу, побачив Ісус силу народу і змилосердився над ними та вигоїв їхніх недужих. Якже настав вечір, підійшли до нього його учні і кажуть: "Пустинне це місце та й час минув уже. Відпусти людей, нехай ідуть по селах та куплять собі поживи." Ісус сказав їм: "Не треба їм відходити, дайте ви їм їсти." Вони ж мовлять до нього: "Ми маємо тут тільки п'ять хлібів і дві риби." Тоді він каже: "Принесіть мені їх сюди." І велівши народові сісти на траві, взяв п'ять хлібів і дві риби, підвів очі до неба, поблагословив і розламав хліби, і дав учням, а учні -- людям. І всі їли до наситу, і назбирали кусків, що зосталися, дванадцять кошів повних. Тих же, що їли, було яких п'ять тисяч чоловік, окрім жінок та дітей. І зараз же заставив учнів увійти до човна і переплисти на той бік раніше від нього, тим часом як відпускав народ.

Head of the Ukrainian Greek Catholic Church in Zarvanytsia: "With hope, we already experience Christ's Victory over death here on Earth"

This pilgrimage, known among Ukrainians as a national pilgrimage, is a special moment of strength, because we are together, united in prayer and in the journey we have made as pilgrims to this holy place. Every time the people unite in their longing for God, they experience their internal, spiritual, undefeatable strength, which is bestowed upon human beings by the power and grace of the Holy Spirit. And today we feel that we are strong

because we are together. This was emphasized by His Beatitude Sviatoslay, Father and Head of the UGCC during his sermon on Sunday, July 20, during the All-Ukrainian pilgrimage to Zarvanytsia. The Head of the Church was joined by bishops of the Ukrainian Greek Catholic Church from Ukraine and around the world. About 25,000 pilgrims took part in the nationwide pilgrimage to Zarvanytsia. In his sermon, His Beatitude Sviatoslav elaborated on the Gospel account of the paralytic, emphasizing that "when a person has trespassed against God, only He can forgive their sins." The Head of the Church also mentioned the prophet Elijah, who "embodies the Old Testament aspirations of man for the one true God," and added that "only when a person focuses all their desires in one direction can they be successful. "When a person does not know what they want, when they are tossed back and forth, seeking one idol after another, they become lax, weak, incapable, immobile. But the moment they unite all their aspirations around the one true God, they discover their inner strength," explained the preacher, pointing to the virtues that a people can attain by living a righteous life. According to him, "when a person transforms the strength of their soul into virtues, they become fiery horses that carry them from earth to heaven. Therefore, the first step for a paralytic to rise up is to turn to God and ask for forgiveness for his sins. "If you have come here to pray for the salvation of your sons, your husbands who are at the front, for the victory of Ukraine, be sure: you are seeking God, who gives this victory. If we pray today for peace, be sure; we are seeking Christ, who is our peace. The Lord wants to give us so much, but each of us must experience our own moment of repentance and conversion today, on this pilgrimage," emphasized the Primate, calling on the pilgrims to proceed to confession. His Beatitude Sviatoslav added: "First, you must empty your heart of evil, and then, be sure, God will give you more than you could have imagined. Only by uniting all our aspirations around the One, we truly become invincible." The Head of the Church noted that this year's pilgrimage is special because it is a jubilee. Pope Francis called it a pilgrimage of hope. "We came here with the hope that what we ask for will be granted when we pray with faith and sincere intention," he said. "In early Christian art, hope was depicted as an anchor, because an anchor holds a boat in place amid the deadly waves of a stormy sea. But the Holy Fathers of the Church taught us that our anchor of hope is not cast down into the depths, but into heaven. For ours is in God. And this anchor of hope draws us to the one in whom we place all our hope. With this hope that does not disappoint, we are already here on earth, as pilgrims, experiencing Christ's triumph over life and death," explained the Patriarch. The Head of the UGCC noted that this year's pilgrimage is dedicated to three anniversaries: the 160th anniversary of the birth of Metropolitan Andrey Sheptytsky, "the most successful builder of the Church and his people of his time": the 30th anniversary of the All-Ukrainian pilgrimage to Zarvanytsia, and the 25th anniversary of the Marian Cathedral in Zarvanytsia, "which, with its golden domes, shines like fire from the earth to the heavens before the eves of pilgrims."

Therefore, the Patriarch praised the Lord for allowing "the jubilee doors to be opened today in this cathedral, through which every pilgrim can receive a plenary indulgence for the Jubilee Year of Hope. Today, the word of God and the prophet Elijah tell us that the most certain way to fulfill all our desires and to reach God is through Mary." "We ask: Mother of God, unite us all in the aspirations of the One whom you hold in your arms, toward whom you guide pilgrims. Mother of God, Our Lady of Perpetual Help of Zarvanytsia, save the sons and daughters of Ukraine — and we will never be ashamed of our hope,"

concluded His Beatitude Sviatoslav.

The Sts. Volodymyr and Olha Ukrainian Catholic Metropolitan Cathedral is a place that represents determination and hope for people who immigrated to Canada from Ukraine in the early 1890's. The current Cathedral church is the third Church for the parish. Construction of this structure began in 1947. The cornerstone for this new Cathedral was blessed in September 1948 by Apostolic Exarch of Canada for Ukrainian Catholics, Basil Ladyka. On April 15, 1951 the Cathedral was officially opened by Cardinal James McGuigan of Toronto, assisted by Archbishop Ladyka.

On November 3, 1956, Pope Pius XII created the Metropolitan See for the Ukrainian Catholics of Canada, Today, this magnificent spiritual gathering place features religious art of paintings, stained glass windows and icons. The stained glass windows depict the Church history of Ukraine and were created by world renowned artist and immigrant Dr. Leo Mol.

Sts. Volodymyr and Olha Cathedral was honoured and blessed to have Pope John Paul II stop for prayer during his visitation in 1984. The chair and kneeler used by Saint John Paul remain in the Cathedral for veneration.

Over the past few years, the Cathedral has become of place of prayers and support for the thousands of Ukrainians that have fled from Ukraine during this time of war. There are displays in the Cathedral to encourage pilgrims to pray, especially for all those that have made sacrifices and are suffering because of the tragedy of war.



Basic Guidelines for Reception of Holy Communion

You are a member of the Catholic Church; You have participated in the Sacrament of Confession at least during the Easter or Christmas seasons this past year if not more frequently; You attend Divine Services regularly; Your lifestyle is consistent with the teaching of the Catholic Church; You have kept the Liturgical fast — no food at least one hour prior to the Divine Liturgy (water and medicine does not break the fast). You have been in church from the beginning of the service, or at least heard the Gospel. To the best of your ability, you are in the state of Grace. If for any of these or other reasons you cannot receive Holy Communion, you are welcome to come for a blessing. Please indicate to the priest that you would like to receive his blessing. For those who are divorced and living common-law the Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist cannot be received. You are



welcome to come for a blessing. (If you are divorced with a Church annulment, and remarried in the Church you are more than welcome to receive the Holy Sacraments.)
