July 6 4th Sunday after Pentecost Our Mother of Perpetual Help

Sunday Tropar, tone 3: Let the heavens be glad, let the earth rejoice,* for the Lord has done a mighty deed with His arm.* He trampled death by death; He became the first born of the dead;* He saved us from the abyss of Hades* and granted great mercy to the world.

Tropar of the Feast, tone 7: O Virgin Mother of God,* your glory we celebrate,* your help we seek,* your miraculous icon we venerate.* You are our gracious Mother,* you are the Hope of the world.* Do not despise our prayers.* but always rescue us from our sorrows and troubles.

Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit,

Kondak of the Feast, tone 6: Our Mother of Perpetual Help,* grant us, we pray, help in difficulties, relief in sickness,* comfort in sorrow, strength in our labours.* Give us, we beesech you, the virtue of piety, unity to Christians,* forgiveness to sinners, perseverance to the righteous,* salvation to the dying, purification to the souls in purgatory* and obtain for them eternal glory.

Now and for ever and ever. Amen.

Sunday Kondak, tone 3: You rose from the tomb, O compassionate Lord,* and led us out from the gates of death.* Today Adam exults and Eve rejoices,* and the prophets together with the patriarchs unceasingly acclaim* the divine might of Your power.

Prokimen, tone 3: Sing to our God, sing; sing to our King, sing.

Verse: Clap your hands, all you nations; shout unto God with the voice of joy.

Epistle: A reading from the Letter of the Holy Apostle Paul to the Romans. (6: 18 - 23) Brothers & Sisters! Freed from your sin, you became slaves of justice. (I use the following example from human affairs because of your weak human nature.) Just as formerly you enslaved your bodies to impurity and licentiousness for their degradation, make them now the servants of justice for your sanctification. When you were slaves of sin, you had freedom from justice. What benefit did you then enjoy? Things you are now ashamed of, all of them tending toward death. But now that you are freed from sin and have become slaves of God, your benefit is sanctification as you tend toward eternal life. The wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Alleluia Verses: In You, O Lord, have I hoped that I may not be put to shame for ever.

Be a protector unto me, O God, and a house of refuge to save me.

Gospel: Matthew 8: 5 - 13 At that time as Jesus entered Capernaum, a centurion approached him with this request: "Sir, my serving boy is at home in bed paralyzed, suffering painfully." He said to him, "I will come and cure him." "Sir," the centurion said in reply, "I am not worthy to have you under my roof. Just give an order and my boy will get better. I am a man under authority myself and I have troops assigned to me. If I give one man the order, 'Dismissed,' off he goes. If I say to another, 'Come here,' he comes. If I tell my slave, 'Do this,' he does it." Jesus showed amazement on hearing this and remarked to his followers, "I assure you, I have never found this much faith in Israel. Mark what I say! Many will come from the east and the west and will find a place at the banquet in the kingdom of God with Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, while the natural heirs of the kingdom will be driven out into the dark. Wailing will be heard there, and the grinding of teeth." To the centurion Jesus said, "Go home. It shall be done because you trusted." That very moment the boy got better.

O my soul, extol the Mother of God*, of Perpetual Help.* Beneath the Cross we heard the words of comfort,* that you are our Mother and we are your children.* Therefore, we have gathered today and sincerely plea:* Place our Church and our nation under Your perpetual help,* for we extol you with faith and love,* as our Mother of Perpetual Help.

The Synod Begins in Rome: His Beatitude Sviatoslav Calls the Faithful to Prayer

His Beatitude Sviatoslav, Father and Head of the Ukrainian Greek Catholic Church, has called on the faithful to pray for the upcoming Synod of Bishops of the Ukrainian Greek Catholic



Church, which begins on June 29. He also renewed his invitation to participate in the Jubilee Pilgrimage of the UGCC to Rome, taking place on June 28. The Primate described the upcoming events as "very special and historic for the life of our Church and our people."

This week, delegations from all our communities—from the entire Ukrainian diaspora around the world—are traveling to Rome, to the Eternal City," said His Beatitude Sviatoslav on Sunday, June 22, following the Divine Liturgy at the Patriarchal Cathedral of the Resurrection of Christ in Kyiv. On Saturday, June

28, a global pilgrimage of UGCC faithful to the tomb of the Apostle Peter will mark the Jubilee Year of Hope. Then, on Sunday, June 29, the feast of the Holy Apostles Peter and Paul, the next session of the UGCC Synod of Bishops will begin with a concelebrated Divine Liturgy with Pope Leo XIV.

Jubilee of the Ukrainian Greek Catholic Church: His Beatitude Sviatoslav Invites the Faithful to the Vatican for a Pilgrimage



The central theme of the ten-day Synod—held at the Ukrainian Pontifical College of St. Josaphat—will be family ministry during wartime. His Beatitude Sviatoslav outlined the mission before the bishops: "Our bishops from around the world will make every effort to ensure that we, as a Church, can support Ukrainian families wounded by war."

He also stressed the importance of spiritual support: "I earnestly ask all of you—pray for the Synod of our bishops, for the grace of the Holy Spirit, the visible sign of His presence in the Church."

His Beatitude emphasized that the main purpose of the pilgrimage to Rome is to pray for peace. "Not only do we want to convey our pain and suffering to Rome, the Vatican, and the world, but also the heroism of our people, our resilience, and our strength. We want the world to hear us and to stand with us," he said.

He concluded by inviting all the faithful to join in prayer for these events, which will be broadcast from Rome by Zhyve TV.

Head of the Ukrainian Greek Catholic Church in the 175th Week of the War: Talk of "Peace Negotiations" with the Aggressor Brings Deep Pain to Ukrainians



It has now been exactly 100 days since Russia once again refused to end its war against Ukraine. This was stated by His Beatitude Sviatoslav, Father and Head of the Ukrainian Greek Catholic Church, in his address marking the 175th week of the devastating war that Russia continues to wage against the Ukrainian people.

The Primate noted that the past week was marked by yet more crimes against humanity committed by the Russian Federation—a week filled with death,

bloodshed, tears, and destruction.

"Yet we thank God that we are alive and can serve—serving with what we have, with what we know, and with what we are able to do," His Beatitude said. "Above all, we are grateful that we can pray. Once again, we want the world to hear: Ukraine stands, Ukraine fights, Ukraine prays!"

Addressing the so-called "peace negotiations" aimed at ending Russia's war on Ukraine, the spiritual leader commented:

"Every mention of possible 'peace talks' with the aggressor brings deep pain to Ukrainians—pain for our misled partners, and pain at the mockery of the very concept of peace."

He thanked Pope Leo for once again speaking to the world about Ukraine's cry for help, and for reminding us that we must never grow accustomed to war.

This Sunday, the Church celebrates All Saints' Day of the Ukrainian people. "In light of this feast," His Beatitude continued, "we reflect on the events that will take place in our Church next week—especially Lay People's Day on June 26. A nationwide pilgrimage will be held in Stradch, near Lviv, in honor of our blessed martyrs, Mykola Konrad and Volodymyr Pryima, patrons of the laity in the UGCC.

His Beatitude also invited all Ukrainians to take part in the national pilgrimage to Rome, which will will be held at St. Peter's Basilica on June 28. "With this pilgrimage, and particularly with the Divine Liturgy concelebrated with Pope Leo on the feast of the Supreme Apostles Peter and Paul, on Sunday, June 29, the next session of the Synod of Bishops of our Church will begin."

He concluded by asking the faithful to pray for the bishops, emphasizing:

"The central theme of this year's Synod will be the pastoral care of the family—the most essential cell of the Church, of the nation, and of society—which has been deeply wounded by this brutal war."





Basic Guidelines for Reception of Holy Communion

You are a member of the Catholic Church; You have participated in the Sacrament of Confession at least during the Easter or Christmas seasons this past year if not more frequently; You attend Divine Services regularly; Your lifestyle is consistent with the teaching of the Catholic Church; You have kept the Liturgical fast — no food at least one hour prior to the Divine Liturgy (water and medicine does not break the fast). You have been in church from the beginning of the service, or at least heard the Gospel. To the best of your ability, you are in the state of Grace. If for any of these or other reasons you cannot receive Holy Communion, you are welcome to come for a blessing. Please indicate to the priest that you would like to receive his blessing. For those who are divorced and living common-law the Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist cannot be received. You are



welcome to come for a blessing. (If you are divorced with a Church annulment, and remarried in the Church you are more than welcome to receive the Holy Sacraments.)
