Glory be to Jesus Christ!

I want to say a few words about the Divine Liturgy. 1. Meeting with Christ. The Liturgy is not just a ritual; it is a living encounter with Jesus Christ in the Word of God and in the Eucharist. 2. Communion – the Bread of Life. At the Liturgy, we receive the Body and Blood of Christ – spiritual food that gives us strength to overcome difficulties and grow in faith. 3. Community Prayer. When we pray together, we support one another. As Christ said: "For where two or three are gathered in my name, there am I among them" (Matthew 18:20). 4. Thanksgiving to God. The Liturgy is a moment to say "thank you" to God for life, health, family, and all the blessings we have. 5. Repentance and Forgiveness. At the beginning of the Liturgy, we acknowledge our sins and ask for forgiveness. This is an opportunity to cleanse the heart and start anew. 6. Hearing God's Word. The Gospel and the homily help us better understand God's will and apply it in our daily lives. 7. Strength for Life. The Liturgy gives spiritual energy, peace, and joy, which we then carry into our families, studies, and work. For whom can the Holy Liturgy be offered: For the living: For health, peace in the family, blessings in work, success in studies, protection on the road, or the conversion of sinners; For special needs (surgery, difficult situations, spiritual struggles); In thanksgiving: birth of a child, birthday, wedding anniversary, recovery from illness. For the deceased: For the repose of the soul, that the Lord may forgive their sins and receive them into His Heavenly Kingdom; On anniversaries of death, the 40th day, or any day as spiritual support for the deceased. Thanksgiving intentions: "For the received blessings of God," "For God's protection over the family," "For the gift of life and health." Petitionary intentions: "For peace and unity in the family," "For resolution of difficult situations," "For conversion." Atonement intentions: "In repentance for sins," "For peace and calm in the heart." Missionary intentions: "For peace in Ukraine," "For soldiers defending the country," "For good vocations to the priesthood and religious life." Let us take advantage of these gifts! ~Fr. M

Літургія дає духовну енергію, мир і радість, які ми потім несемо у свої сім'ї, навчання, роботу. За кого можна жертвувати Святу Літургію: За живих: за здоров'я, мир у сім'ї, благословення на працю, успіх у навчанні, захист у дорозі, навернення грішників; за особливі потреби (операція, важка ситуація, духовна боротьба); за подяку: народження дитини, ювілей, річницю шлюбу, оздоровлення. Third Antiphon: Regular 3rd Antiphon but with the following refrain: O Son of God, crucified in the flesh, save us who sing to You: Alleluia!

Tropar of the Exaltation, tone 1: Save Your people, O Lord, and bless Your inheritance.* Grant victory to Your faithful people against enemies,* and protect Your community by Your cross.

Sunday Kondak, tone 6: With His life-giving hand Christ our God, the Giver of life,* raised all the dead from the murky abyss* and bestowed resurrection upon humanity.* He is for all the Savior,* the resurrection and the life, and the God of all.

To Your cross, O Master, we bow in veneration, and we glorify Your holy Resurrection.

Prokimen, tone 6: Save Your people, O Lord, and bless Your inheritance.

Verse: Unto You I will cry, O Lord my God, lest You turn from me in silence.

Epistle: A reading from the Letter of the Holy Apostle Paul to the Galatians. (2: 16 - 20) Brothers and Sisters! Knowing that a man is not justified by legal observance but by faith in Jesus Christ, we too have believed in him in order to be justified by faith in Christ, not by observance of the law; for by works of the law no one will be justified. But if, in seeking to be justified in Christ, we are shown to be sinners does that mean that Christ is encouraging sin? Unthinkable! If, however, I were to build up the very things I had demolished, I should then indeed be a transgressor. It was through the law that I died to the law, to live for God. I have been crucified with Christ, and the life I live now is not my own; Christ is living in me. I still live my human life, but it is a life of faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.

Alleluia Verses: He who lives in the aid of the Most High, shall dwell under the protection of the God of heaven. He says to the Lord: You are my protector and my refuge, my God, in Whom I hope.

Whoever would preserve his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for my sake and the gospel's will preserve it. What profit does a man show who gains the whole world and destroys himself in the process? What can a man offer in exchange for his life! If anyone in this faithless and corrupt age is ashamed of me and my doctrine, the Son of Man will be ashamed of him when he comes with the holy angels in his Father's glory." He also said to them: "I assure you, among those standing here there are some who will not taste death until they see the reign of

Pope Leo XIV to Eastern Catholics: "The Church Needs You"

Addressing the faithful from the 23 *sui iuris* Churches in full communion with Rome, the Holy Father said, "You are precious in God's eyes," and expressed his happiness at being able to devote one of the first encounters of his pontificate to the Eastern faithful. "Looking at you," he said, "I think of the diversity of your origins, your glorious history, and the bitter sufferings that many of your communities have endured or continue to endure." Recalling the teachings of previous Popes, including Leo XIII and St. John Paul II, Pope Leo XIV emphasized the importance of Eastern traditions, especially the liturgy.

He also expressed concern for "many of our Eastern brothers and sisters" who have been exiled from their homelands "and risk losing not only their native lands," but also their religious identity.

The Church Needs the East "The Church needs you!" Pope Leo said. "The contribution that the Christian East can offer us today is immense," he continued, pointing to the need to recover the sense of mystery expressed in Eastern liturgies; the importance of rediscovering the sense of the primacy of God and of mystagogy (to lead through the Mysteries of the Church); and the need for "penance, fasting, and weeping for one's own sins and for those of all humanity."

"It is vital then, that you preserve your traditions without attenuating them," he said. The Holy Father went on to highlight the "medicinal" value of eastern traditions of spirituality that combine "the drama of human misery with wonder at God's mercy."

"Who better than you," he asked, "can sing a song of hope even amid the abyss of violence."

Taking up Pope Francis' recognition of eastern communities as "martyr Churches," Pope Leo lamented the violence that continues to plague regions as diverse as the Holy Land, Ukraine, the Middle East, Tigray, and the Caucasus."

Commitment to Peace

Pope Leo XIV forcefully expressed his commitment "to make every effort so that peace may prevail," reaffirming the Holy See's willingness to do everything possible "to help bring enemies together, face to face, to talk to one another," to dialogue, "so that peoples everywhere may find hope and recover... the dignity of peace." Appealing directly to the people of the world and their leaders, Pope Leo made a heartfelt appeal: "Let us meet, let us talk, let us negotiate!" He insisted that "war is never inevitable" and called for the silencing of weapons, "which do not resolve problems, but only increase them." He went on to thank God for all those who are "sowing peace," while also expressing gratitude for those Christians, "who, above all in the Middle East, persevere and remain in their homelands, resisting the temptation to abandon them."

The Pope affirmed once again that "Jesus, the Son of Justice," he thanked Eastern Christians "for being 'lights in the world'" and encouraged them to "be outstanding for your faith, hope, and charity, and nothing else."

He called for the pastors of the Eastern Churches to promote "community with integrity," so that their communities might be "places of fraternity and co-responsibility."

"Today more than ever," concluded Pope Leo XIV, "the splendour of the Christian East demands freedom from all worldly attachments, and from every tendency contrary to communion, in order to remain faithful in obedience and in evangelical witness."



Pope Leo XIV at Audience: Trust in God's timing and grace. Most

Rev. Bishop Andrii Rabiy was meeting with Pope Leo after the General Audience.

During his weekly General Audience, Pope Leo XIV reflects on Holy Saturday, and calls on the faithful to always trust in God's power to operate in their lives, even when the wait may feel long and hope may seem lost. "Every suspended time can become a time of grace, if we offer it to God," said Pope Leo XIV during his weekly General Audience on Wednesday morning in the Vatican, after having returned from Castel Gandolfo for an overnight stay on Tuesday evening.

The Holy Father continued his series of catecheses on the Jubilee theme of "Jesus Christ our Hope," focusing this week on the mystery of Holy Saturday, the day of great silence and joyful expectation.

'We struggle to stop and rest'

The Pope recalled that Holy Saturday is also "a day of rest"; yet, he observed, "We struggle to stop and rest." Just as God rested after creating the universe, the Holy Father reflected, so did the Son rest after completing the work of redemption, having loved us to the end.

In this context, Pope Leo acknowledged that while we too are invited to find quiet and restful moments amidst the frenzy of our daily activity, we often dismiss this.

New life begins in silence

"We live as if life were never enough. We rush to produce, to prove ourselves, to keep up. But," he reassured the faithful, "the Gospel teaches us that knowing how to stop is an act of trust that we must learn to perform." Holy Saturday, the Pope said, invites us to discover that life does not always depend on what we do, but also on knowing how to take leave of what we have been able to do. "In the tomb, Jesus, the living Word of the Father," the Pope observed, "is silent. But it is precisely in that silence that the new life begins to ferment," comparing this process to that of a seed in the ground or darkness before dawn.

Even 'useless' time can become precious

"God," the Holy Father therefore reassured the faithful, "is not afraid of the passing time, because He is also the God of waiting. "Thus, even our 'useless' time, that of pauses, emptiness, barren moments," Pope Leo XIV marveled, "can become the womb of resurrection..."

Trusting even when all seems over

"Every suspended time can become a time of grace, if we offer it to God," he said, for "Jesus, buried in the ground, is the meek face of a God who does not occupy all space" and "the God who lets things be done, who waits, who withdraws to leave us freedom."

"He is the God," Pope Leo underscored, "who trusts, even when everything seems to be over."

God works in that slow time of trust. Therefore, the Holy Father invited the faithful to learn from this episode, namely "that we do not have to be in a hurry to rise again," that "first we must stay and welcome the silence" and "let ourselves be embraced by limitation."

Finally, Pope Leo XIV underscored that while we may seek quick answers and immediate solutions, "God works in depth, in the slow time of trust."



"There is no Polish, Ukrainian, or Greek cross only one Cross of the Lord," UGCC Head at the Exaltation of the Cross in Wrocław

On September 14, 2025, on the feast of the Exaltation of the Holy and Life-Giving Cross, His Beatitude Sviatoslav, Father and Head of the Ukrainian Greek Catholic Church, presided over the Hierarchical Divine

Liturgy in the Cathedral of the Exaltation of the Cross in Wrocław on the occasion of the cathedral's feast day. The Primate concelebrated with: Bishop Arkadiusz Trochanowski, Bishop of Olsztyn-Gdańsk, Bishop Mykhailo Bubniy, Exarch of Odessa, newly ordained Bishop Mariusz Dmyterko, Auxiliary Bishop of the Wroclaw-Koszalin Eparchy, Secretary of the Apostolic Nuncio in Poland, and local clergy.

Recalling this event, His Beatitude Sviatoslav emphasized: "A good shepherd is where the pain is most acute. You know what tragedy happened the night before— criminal hands pulled down the Lord's cross from the main dome of the church in this city."

The Head of the UGCC noted that the Lord's cross cannot be divided on national grounds: "There is no Polish, Ukrainian, or Greek cross. There is only one cross—the Cross of the Lord, which is honored today by Catholics, Orthodox Christians, and Protestants. Even those who do not know Christ honor it. Because it is a sign of salvation for all people."

In his address at the end of the Liturgy, the Primate also recalled that on this day Pope Leo XIV celebrates his 70th birthday, and shared that he had sent him greetings on behalf of the entire UGCC: "On this feast day, we ask that God grant him the grace to be a Pope of peace; that he may breathe the spirit of the risen Christ into humanity, which today is deepening its descent into the darkness of war, and may say, 'Peace be with you." Addressing the faithful in Wrocław Cathedral, the Head of the UGCC highlighted the special spiritual bond between this church and the Patriarchal Cathedral in Kyiv: "There is a special spiritual kinship between the cathedral of our Church in Wrocław and the Patriarchal Cathedral in Kyiv. This cathedral is dedicated to the Exaltation of the Holy Cross, while our Patriarchal Cathedral in Kyiv is dedicated to the Resurrection of Christ. Without the Cross, there is no Resurrection... The suffering, death, and Resurrection of Christ constitute a single, indivisible Paschal mystery of redemption and salvation for the human race."

"Our Ukrainian spiritual wisdom says: whoever has enough wisdom and strength to bow down before the crucified Jesus to the ground, the Heavenly Father will lift him up from any fall, from any humiliation, from any distress, by the power of the crucified Savior, to the height of heaven," added the Patriarch.

"May the Lord God bless you all, bestow strength and the grace of the Holy Spirit upon you. May He bless your families, your children, your relatives who are fighting on the front lines, and bless our land with His righteous, true, Christ-like peace." - *His Beatitude Sviatoslav*.

If for any of these or other reasons you cannot receive Holy Communion, you are welcome to come for a blessing. Please indicate to the priest that you would like to receive his blessing. For those who are divorced and living common-law the Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist cannot be received. You are welcome to come for a blessing. (If you are divorced with a Church annulment, and remarried in the Church you are more than welcome to receive the Holy Sacraments.)
