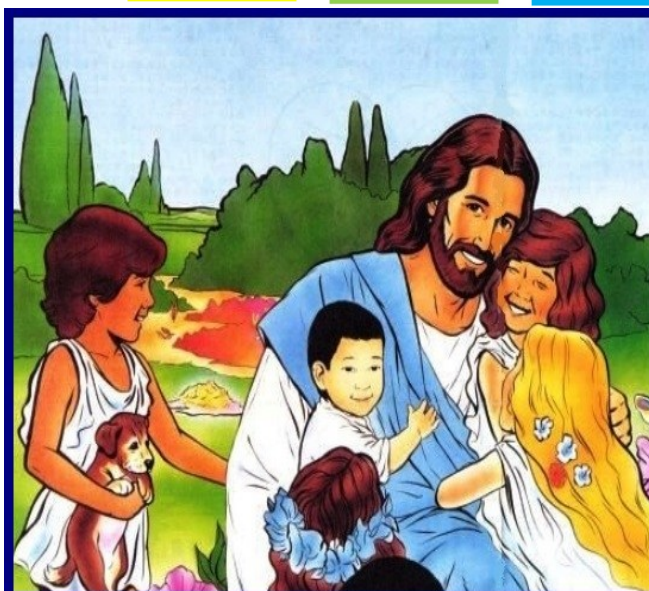

Tropar, tone 7: By Your cross You destroyed death;* You opened Paradise to the thief;* You changed the lamentation of the myrrh-bearers to joy,* and charged the apostles to proclaim* that You are risen, O Christ, our God,* offering great mercy to the world.

Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, now and for ever and ever. Amen.

Kondak, tone 7: No longer shall the dominion of death be able to hold humanity,* for Christ went down shattering and destroying its powers.* Hades is bound.* The prophets exult with one voice.* The Savior has come for those with faith, saying:* “Come forth, O faithful, to the resurrection!”

Prokimen, tone 7: The Lord will give strength to His people; the Lord will bless His people with peace.

Verse: Bring to the Lord, O you sons of God; bring to the Lord young rams.

Epistle: A reading from the Second Letter of the Holy Apostle Paul to the Corinthians. (6: 1 - 10)rothers and Sisters! As your fellow workers we beg you not to receive the grace of God in vain. For He says, “In an acceptable time I have heard you; on a day of salvation I have helped you.” Now is the acceptable time! Now is the day of salvation! We avoid giving anyone offense, so that our ministry may not be blamed. On the contrary, in all that we do we strive to present ourselves as ministers of God, acting with patient endurance amid trials, difficulties, distresses, beatings, imprisonments, and riots; as men familiar with hard work, sleepless nights, and fasting; conducting ourselves with innocence, knowledge, and patience, in the Holy Spirit, in sincere love as men with the message of truth and the power of God; wielding weapons of righteousness with right hand and left, whether honored or dishonored, spoken of well or ill. We are called impostors, yet we are truthful; nobodies who in fact are well known; dead, yet here we are alive; punished, but not put to death; sorrowful, though we are always rejoicing; poor, yet we enrich many. We seem to have nothing, yet everything is ours.

Alleluia Verses: It is good to give praise to the Lord; and to sing in Your name, O Most High. To announce Your mercy in the morning and Your truth every night.

Gospel: Matthew 25: 14 - 30 . At that time, the Lord told this parable: A man was going on a journey. He called in his servants and handed his funds over to them according to each man’s abilities. To one he disbursed five thousand silver pieces, to a second two thousand, and to a third a thousand. Then he went away. Immediately the man who received the five thousand went to invest it and made another five. The man who received the two thousand doubled his figure. The man who received the thousand went off instead and dug a hole in the ground, where he buried his master’s money. After a long absence, the master of those servants came home and settled accounts with them. The man who had received the five thousand came forward bringing the additional five. “My lord,” he said, “You let me have five thousand. Christ-Our Pascha: Catechism of the Ukrainian Catholic Church

A Brief Overview of Our Catechism

“In Christ-Our Pascha, we are called to embody in our daily lives the inheritance of the faith, as transmitted in the light of our theological tradition – to deepen, nurture, and transmit it to future generations [...] May this Catechism, the fruit of joint work and prayer of our entire Church, become for all of us a powerful catalyst for renewal as well as confirmation in the Faith, according to our Eastern Tradition.”

- His Beatitude Sviatoslav Shevchuk, Head and Father of the Ukrainian-Greek Catholic Church (UGCC)

1566 AD: Council of Trent, St. Charles Borromeo published a *Catholic Catechism*.

*** **1596 AD: Ukrainian-Greek Catholic Church in full communion with Rome.** ***

1618 AD: St. Josaphat (Ukrainian Catholic martyr) published a catechism based on the one written from the Council of Trent

“Biggest influence on Ukrainian Catholic Catechetical education was the annexation of Western Ukraine into Austria in 1772 AD.”

1996 AD: Patriarchal Catechetical Commission was formed.

1999 AD: Catechetical Directory of Ukrainian Catholic Church was published

2001 AD: Synod blessed the writing of our own catechism of the Ukrainian Catholic Church

2004 AD: structural overview approved; 50 theologians and Patriarch Sviatoslav Shevchuk led to the writing of the Third Section.

2016 AD: *Chris-Our Pascha* officially published in English

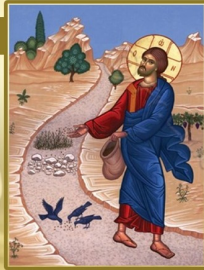

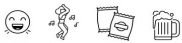

Basic Guidelines for Reception of Holy Communion

You are a member of the Catholic Church; You have participated in the Sacrament of Confession at least during the Easter or Christmas seasons this past year if not more frequently; You attend Divine Services regularly; Your lifestyle is consistent with the teaching of the Catholic Church; You have kept the Liturgical fast – no food at least one hour prior to the Divine Liturgy (water and medicine does not break the fast). You have been in church from the beginning of the service, or at least heard the Gospel. To the best of your ability, you are in the state of Grace. ***If for any of these or other reasons you cannot receive Holy Communion, you are welcome to come for a blessing. Please indicate to the priest that you would like to receive his blessing.*** For those who are divorced and living common-law the Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist cannot be received. You are welcome to come for a blessing. (If you are divorced with a Church annulment, and remarried in the Church you are more than welcome to receive the Holy Sacraments.)
