

Feast of Christ the King

Tropar, tone 4: Christ, Our God, Your kingship has taken us out of the power of darkness* and brought us into the Kingdom of Your love.* You who are eternal, appeared as a King.* Lord, glory be to You.

Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, now and for ever and ever. Amen.

Kondak, tone 7: Let us adore and fall down before the immortal King of the ages,* the only all-wise God Christ, saying:* Power, honor and kingdom have been bestowed upon You,* and for this reason all the nations will serve You.* Your power is everlasting* and Your kingdom will not crumble,* because the eternal King Christ* became King for our sake.

Prokimen, tone 3: Sing to our God, sing; sing to our King, sing.

Verse: God is king of the whole world: play your best in his honor!

Epistle: A reading from the Letter of the Holy Apostle Paul to the Colossians. (1: 12 - 20) Brothers and Sisters! Give thanks to the Father for having made you worthy to share the lot of the saints in light. He rescued us from the power of darkness and brought us into the kingdom of his beloved Son. Through him we have redemption, the forgiveness of our sins. He is the image of the invisible God, the first-born of all creatures. In him everything in heaven and on earth was created, things visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominations, principalities or powers; all were created through him, and for him. He is before all else that is. In him everything continues in being. It is he who is head of the body, the church; he who is the beginning, the first-born of the dead, so that primacy may be his in everything. It pleased God to make absolute fullness reside in him and by means of him, to reconcile everything in his person both on earth and in the heavens, making peace through the blood of his cross.

Alleluia Verses: His empire shall stretch from sea to sea, from the river to the ends of the earth.

All kings will do Him homage, all nations become his servants.

Gospel: John 18:33 - 37

At that time, Pilate went back into the praetorium and summoned Jesus. "Are you the King of the Jews?" he asked him. Jesus answered, "Are you saying this on your own, or have others been telling you about me?" "I am no Jew!" Pilate retorted. "It is your own people and the chief priests who have handed you over to me. What have you done?" Jesus answered: "My kingdom does not belong to this world. If my kingdom were of this world, my subjects would be fighting to save me from being handed over to the Jews. As it is, my kingdom is not here." At this Pilate said to him, "So, then, you are a king?" Jesus replied: "It is you who say I am a king. The reason I was born, the reason why I came into the world is to testify to the truth. Anyone committed to the truth hears my voice." My soul, glorify Christ* who became the King of the universe.* Lord God, the Son of the eternal Father,* became Man by the Virgin and appeared among us* to enlighten those who dwelt in darkness,* and to assemble those who were scattered.* For this reason we glorify* the ever-praised Mother of God.



From our Archeparchy, there were about 15 participants, including two our Catechist Teachers Iryna Khomitska and Natalia Hotel from our parish.

The meeting was very fruitful, engaging, and filled with a spirit of friendship. It was a joy to meet, share experiences, and listen to others. We believe this initiative will serve as a wonderful encouragement for all Catechists to continue spiritual



STRUCTURE OF THE GATHERINGS FOR CATECHISTS

- ➤ Each gathering will consist of **four components**, each lasting **20 minutes** (total duration: **1 hour 20 minutes**):
- 1. Prayer (10 minutes at the beginning and 10 minutes at the end)
- 2. Reflection on the Texts
- 3. Sharing of Personal Experiences
- 4. Professional Development





Why is it important to invite a priest with Holy Communion to visit sick parishioners at home?

Inviting a priest to visit sick parishioners at home — especially with Holy Communion — is a deeply meaningful and important act for several spiritual and pastoral reasons:

1. Spiritual Strength and Comfort

When a person is sick, especially for a long time, physical weakness can often lead to emotional or spiritual fatigue.

Receiving Holy Communion brings the real presence of Christ — the Bread of Life — who strengthens, comforts, and renews the soul. It reminds the person that they are not alone, that Christ is with them even in suffering.



2. Connection with the Church Community

A priest's visit symbolizes that the Church — the Body of Christ — has not forgotten its sick members.

The home visit connects the person to the wider faith community, showing that they still belong, that they are prayed for, and that their suffering has meaning within the Church.

3. Opportunity for Confession and Anointing

During the visit, the priest can also offer the Sacrament of Reconciliation (Confession) and the Anointing of the Sick if needed.

These sacraments bring forgiveness, peace, and often even healing — physical or spiritual — preparing the person's heart to receive Communion worthily.

4. A Moment of Hope and Faith

The presence of a priest and the sacraments can lift the person's spirit, offering hope, courage, and inner peace.

For family members and caregivers, the visit is also a moment of grace — reminding them that caring for the sick is a sacred duty and a work of mercy.

5. Continuing the Mission of Christ

Jesus Himself often visited and healed the sick.

When the priest brings Holy Communion, he continues Christ's own ministry of compassion. It is the Church living out Jesus' command:

"I was sick and you visited Me." (Matthew 25:36)

Inviting a priest with Holy Communion to a sick person's home is more than a kind gesture — it is an act of faith, love, and unity.

It brings Christ's healing presence into the home, strengthens the soul, and reminds everyone involved that even in illness, God's grace is near.





SEVEN SACRAMENTS (HOLY MYSTERIES) OF THE UKRAINIAN GREEK CATHOLIC CHURCH

<u>Baptism</u>: It is the beginning of a new life with God and is the initial step to salvation. We join Jesus Christ in His death and Resurrection. The immersion into blessed water washes away the original sin and we become "new creatures" (children of the light) clothed in Christ, heirs to the Kingdom of Heaven.

Chrismation: Through anointing with Holy Chrism, we are sealed with the gift of the Holy Spirit. We become temples of the Holy Trinity where the Holy Spirit sanctifies us. In our faith, Baptism and Chrismation are received together. Chrismation is similar to Confirmation in the Roman Catholic Church.

The Most Holy Eucharist (Holy Communion): Christ gives us His very self through the Holy Eucharist (the true presence of His Body and Blood). Instituted through the Last (Mystical) Supper on Holy Thursday (Matthew 26:26-28), the Eucharist offers the faithful to participate in receiving eternal life. We are fed and nourished by Christ Himself as His death and Resurrection become present to

Repentance (Reconciliation/Penance): This Mystery allows us to return to God from the sins we have committed against the Holy Trinity and others. By reflecting (prayerful examination of conscience) on our lives, we have contrition for our offenses, and we make a firm commitment to change our ways and confess our shortcomings/sins to a priest (who has been given the authority to absolve us of these sins).

Anointing of the Sick: When a baptized Catholic become gravely sick/ill, this Mystery is "celebrated in order to strengthen one's faith in Christ's victory over sin and death." (Christ Our Pascha; §465) Through God's grace, the sick individual can participate more fully in the Passion of Christ, receiving spiritual (and even physical) healing. It includes the consecration of oil, readings from the Epistles and the Gospels, and the anointing of the afflicted by a priest and/or bishop.

Holy Orders (Holy Mystery of Service): By the power of the Holy Spirit and through the laying on of hands by the bishop (Apostolic Succession and tradition), a man is ordained to serve the Holy Trinity, receiving the grace, authority, and power to perform the sacred responsibilities of a deacon, priest (presbyter), or bishop. Also, other monastic and religious orders allow men and women to consecrate themselves to God (e.g. Sister Servants of Mary Immaculate) to serve God and others as religious brothers and sisters.

Marriage (Holy Mystery of Service): Marriage is a Mystery of love between a man and a woman. "In their gender differentiation, a man and a woman complete one another, creating an indissoluble union of one body." (Christ Our Pascha; §472) The communion of marriage reflects not just the love of a family, it also exemplifies the love that exists between Christ and His Bride, the Catholic Church.

Basic Guidelines for Reception of Holy Communion

You are a member of the Catholic Church; You have participated in the Sacrament of Confession at least during the Easter or Christmas seasons this past year if not more frequently; You attend Divine Services regularly; Your lifestyle is consistent with the teaching of the Catholic Church; You have kept the Liturgical fast — no food at least one hour prior to the Divine Liturgy (water and medicine does not break the fast). You have been in church from the beginning of the service, or at least heard the Gospel. To the best of your ability, you are in the state of Grace. If for any of these or other reasons you cannot receive Holy Communion, you are welcome to come for a blessing. Please indicate to the priest that you would like to receive his blessing. For those who are divorced and living common-law the Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist cannot be received. You are welcome to come for a blessing. (If you are divorced with a Church annulment, and remarried in the Church you are more than welcome to receive the Holy Sacraments.)
