Dear Friends in Christ, yesterday, on Saturday, we commemorated the sorrowful tragedy of the Holodomor famine in Ukraine.

It is a day when we do not simply speak about history, but a day when we remember, we pray, and we learn.

We pray for the souls of millions of innocent victims, and we learn a lesson for ourselves and for the world — that such evil must never be repeated.

Sadly, while we remember the Holodomor, we are also witnessing a modern genocide, a horrific war that Russia continues to wage against Ukraine. Just several days ago, we saw heartbreakingly news from Ternopil, where more than 25 civilians, including children and the elderly, were killed while sleeping in their beds.

Let us continue to pray for Ukraine, that God will put an end to this war,

and that God's victory of truth and justice will triumph over evil.

I also wish to express my sincere gratitude to everyone who worked so hard to prepare our parish dinner. Thank you to Amanda Downie and to all our volunteers who helped with love and dedication. It was a successful and beautiful event that reflected the warmth of our community.

As we continue our journey toward Christmas through the Christmas Fast, let us remember: God does not come to the perfect people — He comes only to the open hearts. Let us prepare such a place for Him. ~Fr. M

Тож продовжуймо молитися за Україну, щоб Господь поклав край цій війні і щоб Божа перемога правди й справедливості перемогла зло.







Sunday Tropar, tone 7: By Your cross You destroyed death;* You opened Paradise to the thief;* You changed the lamentation of the myrrh-bearers to joy,* and charged the apostles to proclaim* that You are risen, O Christ, our God,* offering great mercy to the world.

Feast Day Tropar, tone 4: Today is the prelude of the benevolence of God,* and the herald of the salvation of mankind,* for the Virgin openly appears in the temple of God* and foretells Christ to all.* Let us also with full voice exclaim to her: * “Hail, fulfillment of the Creator’s plan.”

Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, now and for ever and ever. Amen.

Sunday Kondak, tone 7: No longer shall the dominion of death be able to hold humanity,* for Christ went down shattering and destroying its powers.* Hades is bound.* The prophets exult with one voice.* The Savior has come for those with faith, saying: * “Come forth, O faithful, to the resurrection!”

Prokimen, tone 7: The Lord will give strength to His people; the Lord will bless His people with peace.

Verse: Bring to the Lord, O you sons of God; bring to the Lord young rams.

Epistle: A reading from the Letter of the Holy Apostle Paul to the Ephesians. (2: 14 - 22) Brothers and Sisters! It is Christ who is our peace, and who made the two of us one by breaking down the barrier of hostility that kept us apart. In his own flesh he abolished the law with its commands and precepts, to create in himself one new man from us who had been two and to make peace, reconciling both of us to God in one body through his cross, which put that enmity to death. He came and “announced the good news of peace to you who were far off, and to those who were near”; through him we both have access in one Spirit to the Father. This means that you are strangers and aliens no longer. No, you are fellow citizens of the saints and members of the household of God. You form a building which rises on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, with Christ Jesus himself as the capstone. Through him the whole structure is fitted together and takes shape as a holy temple in the Lord; in him you are being built into this temple, to become a dwelling place for God in the Spirit.

Alleluia Verses: It is good to give praise to the Lord; and to sing in Your name, O Most High. To announce Your mercy in the morning and Your truth every night.

Gospel: Luke 8: 41 - 56 At that time, a man named Jairus, who was chief of the synagogue, came up and fell at Jesus’ feet, begging that he come to his home because his only daughter, a girl of about twelve, was dying. As Jesus went, the crowds almost crushed him. A woman with a hemorrhage of twelve years’ duration, incurable at any doctor’s hands, came up behind him and touched the tassel on his cloak. Immediately her bleeding stopped. Jesus asked, “Who touched me?” Everyone disclaimed doing it, while Peter said, “Lord, the crowds are milling and pressing around you!” Jesus insisted, “Someone touched me, I know that power has gone forth from me.” When the woman saw that her act had not gone unnoticed, she came forward trembling. Falling at his feet, she related before the whole assemblage why she had touched him and how she had been instantly cured. Jesus said to her, “Daughter, it is your faith that has cured you. Now go in peace.”

He was still speaking when a man came from the ruler's house with the announcement, "Your daughter is dead; do not bother the Teacher further." Jesus heard this, and his response was: "Fear is useless, what is needed is trust and her life will be spared." Once he had arrived at the house, he permitted no one to enter with him except Peter, John, James and the child's parents. While everyone wept and lamented her, he said, "Stop crying for she is not dead but asleep." They laughed at him, being certain she was dead. He took her by the hand and spoke these words: "Get up, child." The breath of life returned to her and she got up immediately; whereupon he told them to give her something to eat. Her parents were astounded, but he ordered them not to tell anyone what had happened.

Seeing the entry of Mary the most Pure,* the angels marveled at how a virgin could enter the holy of holies.* Since no hand of the wicked* may touch the living Tabernacle of God,* may the lips of the faithful endlessly sing out with joy* to the Mother of God the greetings of the angel: "O pure virgin,* you are truly above all creatures!"

Communion Hymn: Praise the Lord from the heavens, praise Him in the highest.

Прокімен, глас 7: Господь силу людям Своїм дасть, Господь поблагословить людей своїх миром.

Стих: Принесіть Господеві, сини Божі, принесіть Господеві молодих баранців.

Апостол: До Ефесян послання святого апостола Павла читання. (2: 14 - 22)

Браття і Сестри! Христос -- наш мир, він, що зробив із двох одне, зруйнувавши стіну, яка була перегородою, тобто ворожнечу, -- своїм тілом скасував закон заповідей у своїх рішеннях, на те, щоб із двох зробити в собі одну нову людину, вчинивши мир, і щоб примирити їх обох в однім тілі з Богом через хрест, убивши ворожнечу в ньому. Він прийшов звістувати мир вам, що були далеко, і мир тим, що були близько; бо через нього, одні й другі, масно доступ до Отця в однім Дусі. Отже ви більше не чужинці і не приходні, а співгromадяни святих і домашні Божі, побудовані на підвальні апостолів і пророків, де наріжним каменем -- сам Ісус Христос. На ньому вся будівля, міцно споєна, росте як святий храм у Господі; на ньому ви теж будуетесь разом на житло Бога в Дусі.

Стихи на Алилуя: Добре воно прославляти Господа, і співати імені Твоєму, Всешишній.

Звіщати вранці милість Твою, і ночами твою вірність.

Євангелія: Від Луки 8: 41 - 56 В той час один чоловік приступив до Ісуса, Яір на ім'я, що був головою синагоги. Припавши до ніг Ісуса, він став просити зайти до нього в хату, бо була в нього дочка одиначка, яких дванадцять років, і вона вмирала. І як він ішов туди, люди тиснулися до нього. Аж тут якась жінка, що була хвора дванадцять років на кровотечу і витратила на лікарів увесь свій прожиток, і ніхто з них не міг її оздоровити, підійшовши ззаду, доторкнулась краю його одежі, і вміть стала здоровою -- спинилася її кровотеча. Ісус спитав: "Хто доторкнувся мене?" А що всі відпекувались, Петро мовив: "Наставнику, люди коло тебе товпляться й тиснуться!" Ісус сказав: "Хтось доторкнувся до мене, бо я чув, як сила вийшла з мене." Побачивши жінка що не втایтися, тремтячи підійшла і, упавши йому до ніг, призналася перед усіма людьми, чому до нього доторкнулась і як негайно одужала. Сказав їй Ісус: "Дочки, віра твоя спасла тебе, іди в мир!" Він говорив іще, як ось приходить хтось від голови синагоги і каже: "Твоя дочка померла, не турбуй більше учителя." Ісус, почувши це, озвавсь до нього: "Не бійся, тільки віруй, і вона спасеться." Прийшовши до хати, він не пустив нікого з собою всередину, крім Петра, Івана та Якова з батьком та матір'ю дитини. Всі плакали за нею й голосили. Він мовив: "Не плачте, вона не вмерла, вона спить." Ті сміялися з нього, бо знали, що вмерла. Тоді він узяв її за руку і голосно промовив: "Дівчина, встань!" І дух її вернувсь до неї, і вона вміть всталла. Він велів дати їй їсти. Батьки ж її були здивовані вельми, та наказав їм нікому не говорити, що сталося.

Ангели, бачачи вхід Пречистої, здивувалися,* як Діва ввійшла у святая святих.* Як одухотвореного Божого кивота* нехай ніяк не діткнеться рука скверних,* а уста вірних нехай, невмовкаючи,* з радістю кличуть до Богородиці,* голос ангела виспівуючи: "Справді, Ти є вище всіх, Діво чистая!"

Причасний: Хваліте Господа з небес, хваліте Його на висотах.

A Simplified Summary on How to Become Holier and Closer to God

How can I grow in holiness? Is holiness even attainable for me, a sinner? Can everyone reach the highest level of what it means to be holy? The answer is YES! It might seem impossible at times to live a pious and holy life, but with God and His grace, nothing is impossible. He extends a universal call to everyone, including you!

Holiness (Latin: *sanctitas*) is a “*spiritual progress that directs the soul toward an ever more intimate union with Christ. [...] It is the way of perfection that passes by the way of the Cross, [...] there is no holiness without renunciation and spiritual battle.*” (Vatican Website; Catechism, Christian Holiness; §2014-2015) Although it may seem daunting, Jesus Christ, through His death on the Cross and Resurrection, has cleansed us from the stain of sin. He has chosen all of us to be holy.

There is a simplified **Seven-Step Process to Holiness** outlined by Deacon Steve Greco (July 10, 2024; <https://catholicstand.com/a-seven-step-process-to-holiness/>). Below is a summary of his article.

The first step (1) is to desire holiness. We are called to be holy. We are called to be saints. Mother Teresa told us we must desire to be holy and expect that we will become holy.

The second step (2) is to surrender our lives to Jesus. We can't achieve this if we have one foot in the world and one foot with Jesus. If we are lukewarm, Jesus will “spit” us out of His mouth, as seen in Revelation 3. When we seek God with all our hearts and hunger and thirst for Him, we will receive the grace for holiness.

The third step (3) is to continuously repent of our weaknesses and sins. Have we forgiven ourselves for our sins? Have we forgiven others for the hurt they have caused us? Let's develop the habit of reviewing our conscience each evening and regularly going to Reconciliation (Confession).

The fourth step (4) is to ask for faith, faith that moves mountains and guides us toward deeper holiness. Through faith, we experience miracles. Faith, through Jesus' love, heals us.

The fifth step (5) is to learn how to pray fervently. Most of us pray by asking God for things. It is essential that we learn to pray from our hearts, starting with praising God for who He is. Prayer and praise help us to be thankful for what God has done for us. It often involves praying in the Spirit. This also leads us to the Blessed Mother and the Rosary. Praying through Mary is the best way to become a saint. She guides us to the will of her Son, Jesus.

The sixth step (6) toward holiness is to love fervently. Ask God to teach you how to love. It is the most important act you can perform. It begins with God teaching you how to open your heart to receive the love He has for you. To love in holiness and with the love of the Father, we **must learn how to forgive**.

The seventh step (7) to be holy means you are living a sacramental life. It requires leading a life in which you hunger and thirst for the Divine Liturgy and Eucharist.

“⁷ *I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith.* ⁸ *From now on, there is reserved for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous judge, will give me on that day, and not only to me but also to all who have longed for his appearing.*” (2 Timothy 4:7-8)

The journey to holiness is lifelong. We were created to be holy and in full communion with God. Original sin tarnished this relationship, but through Jesus Christ's salvific actions, we can once again become holy (as intended) and live eternally in God's Kingdom! **Never give up!**

Glory be to Jesus Christ! Glory be forever!

Chapter 5: The Journey Home

The boy (who is nameless at this point in the story) and his wolf companion (who found and raised him in the wild) return the kidnapped apelings to their family.

Chapter 6: Lumpy's Family

The boy talks with the father of the apelings about the importance of family and how it's something worth dying for. Comically, the father of the apelings tries to set the boy up with his cousin, who the boy politely rejects. The boy's wolf companion, Ava, tells him it's time to leave because winter is approaching.



Chapter 7: Henry the Bear

On the way back to their cave, the boy and wolf find Henry the Bear, a seemingly goodnatured friend of the boy's. He asks if he can join them on their walk home. Ava is suspicious, but the boy is too innocent to anticipate a trick.

Chapter 8: The Tunnel to Snake Mountain

The boy, wolf and bear journey through a hidden tunnel that leads to Snake Valley, which is close to where the boy's cave is. At one point, the bear gets the boy alone and tells him that he's been lonely, that the boy has been like a cub to him, that he's worried the wolf might almost starve again this winter and that he has a surprise for him.



Chapter 9: Henry's Surprise

The bear reveals a fruit tree growing off the side of Snake Mountain. All of the deadly snakes suddenly leave the mountain when they feel winter's first gust of wind. The bear tempts him to climb and get it, saying that the extra food for him would prevent the wolf from starving. All he has to do is cut the branch and it will fall into a pool of water at the bottom.

Chapter 10: The Fall

After the wolf fails to persuade the boy to leave the fruit alone, he begins to climb. A storm cloud suddenly emerges when he's halfway up, giving him a choice to turn back. He chooses to keep going. The storm knocks him off when he reaches the top. He falls, breaking most of his bones.



Chapter 11: Henry Changes

The bear betrays the boy and tries to eat him, but the wolf defends him. The bear nearly kills them both, but stops and flees when he hears the wolf's former pack coming. The wolf's former pack hates her and the boy intensely and is even more dangerous than the bear. The wolf carries the boy back to the cave with her old pack chasing them, barely escaping.

Chapter 12: The Cave

The boy is hurt badly and on the verge of death. As the wolf cleans his wounds, she tries to keep him from passing out by talking about his childhood. The reader learns how she found him as a baby in the snow, what life was like in the cave and the first time he crawled out. After talking about this, he decides he wants to leave the forest in spring in search of a real home. The wolf promises to accompany him as he follows the sun, hoping that it will help him survive winter.

TERRIBLE TRACES OF A RUSSIAN TERRORIST ATTACK (NOVEMBER 19) on a high-rise building in the city of Ternopil. A photo from the scene of the tragedy was published by Fr. Roman Demush. As of now, it is known about 25 dead (three of them children) and 73 wounded, of which 15 are children (information is being updated). Emergency workers rescued 45 people. "We pray for everyone. The living and the dead" !

"Many families in Ternopil

today lost their homes, on the contrary, their property. They will have nowhere to spend the night and nothing to eat. In addition to the UGCC, we are opening a shelter and an aid point for victims of the morning attack at the parish of the UGCC Archangel Michael (15 April Street, 1). Please bring food, warm clothes, blankets, blankets, and pillows here," the Ternopil-Zboriv Archeparchy of the UGCC informs. Russia once again showed its terrorist face. Overnight, multiple regions came under a massive missile and drone attack, including Western regions — Lviv, Ivano-Frankivsk, and Ternopil. Firefighting operations are still underway. Due to this chlorine levels in the air exceed the norm by six times. No military targets. Only civilian infrastructure and peaceful residents. No place is safe when Russia is your neighbour. Help Ukraine protect skies and save lives.



Basic Guidelines for Reception of Holy Communion

You are a member of the Catholic Church; You have participated in the Sacrament of Confession at least during the Easter or Christmas seasons this past year if not more frequently; You attend Divine Services regularly; Your lifestyle is consistent with the teaching of the Catholic Church; You have kept the Liturgical fast – no food at least one hour prior to the Divine Liturgy (water and medicine does not break the fast). You have been in church from the beginning of the service, or at least heard the Gospel. To the best of your ability, you are in the state of Grace. **If for any of these or other reasons you cannot receive Holy Communion, you are welcome to come for a blessing. Please indicate to the priest that you would like to receive his blessing. For those who are divorced and living common-law the Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist cannot be received. You are welcome to come for a blessing. (If you are divorced with a Church annulment, and remarried in the Church you are more than welcome to receive the Holy Sacraments.)**
