Дорогі парафіяні,





Gospel: Luke 16: 19 - 31

The Lord told this parable: “Once there was a rich man who dressed in purple and linen and feasted splendidly every day. At his gate lay a beggar named Lazarus who was covered with sores. Lazarus longed to eat the scraps that fell from the rich man’s table. The dogs even came and licked his sores. Eventually the beggar died. He was carried by angels to the bosom of Abraham. The rich man likewise died and was buried. From the abode of the dead where he was in torment, he raised his eyes and saw Abraham afar off, and Lazarus resting in his bosom. He called out, ‘Father Abraham, have pity on me. Send Lazarus to dip the tip of his finger in water to refresh my tongue, for I am tortured in these flames.’ ‘My child,’ replied Abraham, ‘remember that you were well off in your lifetime, while Lazarus was in misery. Now he has found consolation here, but you have found torment. And that is not all. Let him be a warning to them so that they may not end in this place of torment.’ Abraham answered, ‘They have Moses and the prophets. Let them hear them.’ ‘No, Father Abraham,’ replied the rich man, ‘But if someone would only go to them from the dead, then they would repent.’ Abraham said to him, ‘If they do not listen to Moses and the prophets, they will not be convinced even if one should rise from the dead.’ ”

Patriarch Sviatoslav: Let Us Pray Especially for the Defenders of Pokrovsk in Donbas

This week marks the 194th week of a war that has been raging for 11 years. Yet we count these weeks from the beginning of the full-scale invasion of our peaceful Ukrainian land by the Russian aggressor. This was stated by His Beatitude Sviatoslav, Father and Head of the Ukrainian Greek Catholic Church, in his traditional video address.

“It was a week of heroic struggle—a struggle to defend and protect our homeland,” said the Primate. Concluding this period, His Beatitude Sviatoslav once again thanked God and the Armed Forces of Ukraine for keeping us alive: “Thanks to the professionalism of our defenders, dozens and hundreds of enemy vehicles were destroyed, and millions of lives were saved. We thank our defenders—young men and women—for ensuring that life in Ukraine triumphed once again this week.”

The Head of the Church urged everyone to pray especially for the defenders of Pokrovsk in Donbas, the defenders of Kupiansk in the Kharkiv region, and those in the Sumy and Chernihiv borderlands, as well as in Zaporizhzhia and Dnipro.

The Primate also thanked the energy sector workers who are fighting for light in Ukraine, and the fighters who ensured that the enemy was unable to break the resilience of Ukrainians on this front this week. He separately offered prayers and gratitude to God for the courage and fortitude of Ukraine’s railway workers, who heroically maintain the functioning of cities and villages even at the cost of their own lives and health.

“Therefore, once again, we want the whole world to know about this heroism of the Ukrainian people. Let the world know that this week Ukraine stands, Ukraine fights, Ukraine prays!” said the spiritual leader.

Despite shelling and blackouts, according to His Beatitude, the Patriarchal Cathedral of the Resurrection of Christ in Kyiv welcomed pilgrims this Sunday. As part of the anniversary pilgrimage of the Year of Hope, worshippers of the long-running ‘Rosary Unites’ initiative arrived at the cathedral. For five years now, every day at 8 p.m. Kyiv time, tens of thousands of Ukrainians have been praying for their homeland.

The spiritual leader thanked all the faithful who have joined in this prayer daily for the past five years: “Thank you to everyone who heeded Pope Leo’s call and prayed the rosary in October. This Sunday, we conclude this time of prayer and thank everyone who responded with their hearts and stood in prayer before God.” His Beatitude Sviatoslav also mentioned the great saint and ascetic—the father of our Church in the 20th century—the righteous Metropolitan Andrey Sheptytsky: “This year we celebrated the 160th anniversary of his birth, and yesterday, November 1, we traditionally commemorated the day of his passing into eternity. 

The Feast of the Synaxis of the Archangel Michael and the Other Bodiless Powers of Heaven (November 8)

The Feast of the Synaxis of the Archangel Michael and Other Heavenly Bodiless Powers was established at the beginning of the 4th century at the Council (Synod) of Laodicea, which met several years before the First Ecumenical Council (the Council of Nicaea 325 AD).

The Angelic Ranks (which include Nine Choirs) can be divided into three Hierarchs according to St. Thomas Aquinas in his *Summa Theologiae (Questions 106-114)*.

Highest Ranks of Angels: Seraphim (angels closest to God), Cherubim, and Thrones. These angels are profoundly connected in unity with God as they possess a greater perspective of the universal/divine truth and knowledge than the other angels (the truth and knowledge of God Himself).

Middle Ranks of Angels: Dominions, Virtues, and Powers. These angels are to govern and administer the divine plan/idea in the material world (the world in which humans live) through the first three choirs.

Lowest Ranks of Angels: Principalities, Archangels, and Angels. This rank understands the knowledge communicated from the higher choirs. They are concerned with God's plan of salvation humankind. They have been tasked with the guardianship of nations, societies, and individuals. It is from this rank that we are assigned a guardian angel through God's will. The choir of Archangels include *St. Michael, St. Gabriel, and St. Raphael* (we know of Seven Archangels; Tobit 12:15). The Archangels, through Holy Scripture, **bear the greatest of messages from God to humankind.** These are the chief messengers (*arch-aggelos*).

Michael (Hebrew): "**who is like God.**" St. Michael battled the dragon (Revelation 12:7)

Gabriel (Hebrew): "**man of God**" or "**strength of God.**" St. Gabriel was sent to Nazareth to the Blessed Virgin to deliver the glorious news of Jesus Christ (*Emmanuel: "God is with us"*) (Luke 1:26-27)

Raphael (Hebrew): "**God heals.**" (Tobit 12:15)

Pope Leo XIII (1810-1903 AD), upon his *horrid* vision after celebrating Holy Mass (October 13, 1884 AD), composed this prayer to be recited, especially when praying the Holy Rosary...

Saint Michael the Archangel, defend us in battle. Be our protection against the wickedness and snares of the devil. May God rebuke him, we humbly pray; and do Thou, O Prince of the Heavenly Host, by the Divine Power of God, cast into hell Satan and all the evil spirits who roam throughout the world seeking the ruin of souls.

Troparion (Tone 4): Princes of the heavenly hosts, * we, though unworthy, beg you * to encircle us through your prayers * under the shelter of the wings of your spiritual glory. * Guard us as we come to you and sincerely cry: * "Deliver us from dangers, * O princes of the powers on high!"

Glory be to Jesus Christ! Glory be forever!

Basic Guidelines for Reception of Holy Communion

You are a member of the Catholic Church; You have participated in the Sacrament of Confession at least during the Easter or Christmas seasons this past year if not more frequently; You attend Divine Services regularly; Your lifestyle is consistent with the teaching of the Catholic Church; You have kept the Liturgical fast – no food at least one hour prior to the Divine Liturgy (water and medicine does not break the fast). You have been in church from the beginning of the service, or at least heard the Gospel. To the best of your ability, you are in the state of Grace. **If for any of these or other reasons you cannot receive Holy Communion, you are welcome to come for a blessing. Please indicate to the priest that you would like to receive his blessing. For those who are divorced and living common-law the Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist cannot be received. You are welcome to come for a blessing. (If you are divorced with a Church annulment, and remarried in the Church you are more than welcome to receive the Holy Sacraments.)**
