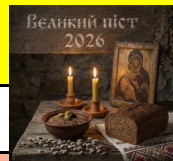

Sunday Tropar, tone 8: You came down from on high, O Merciful One,* and accepted three days of burial* to free us from our sufferings.* O Lord, our life and our resurrection,* glory be to You.

Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, now and for ever and ever. Amen.

Kondak of the 5th Sunday of Lent , tone 3: Formerly laden with every kind of immorality,* today because of your repentance, you were made a bride of Christ,* longing for citizenship with angels* crushing demons by the Cross as your weapon.* And so, glorious Mary, you became a bride of heaven.

Prokimen, tone 8: Pray and give praise to the Lord our God.

Verse: In Judea God is known; His name is great in Israel.

Epistle: A reading from the Epistle to the Hebrews. (9: 11 - 14) Brothers and Sisters! When Christ came as high priest of the good things which have come to be, he entered once for all into the sanctuary passing through the greater and more perfect tabernacle not made by hands, that is, not belonging to this creation. He entered, not with the blood of goats and calves, but with his own blood, and achieved eternal redemption. For if the blood of goats and bulls and the sprinkling of a heifer's ashes can sanctify those who are defiled so that their flesh is cleansed, how much more will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal spirit offered himself up unblemished to God, cleanse our consciences from dead works to worship the living God!

Alleluia Verses: Come, let us rejoice in the Lord; let us acclaim God our Savior. Let us come before His countenance with praise and acclaim Him with psalms.

Gospel: Mark 10: 32 - 45 At that time, Jesus taking the twelve aside once more, began to tell them what was going to happen to him. "We are on our way up to Jerusalem, where the Son of Man will be handed over to the chief priests and the scribes. They will condemn him to death and hand him over to the Gentiles, who will mock him and spit at him, flog him, and finally kill him. But three days later he will rise. Zebedee's sons, James and John, approached him, "Teacher," they said, "we want you to grant our request." "What is it?" he asked. They replied, "See to it that we sit, one at your right and the other at your left, when you come into your glory." Jesus told them, "You do not know what your are asking. Can you drink the cup I shall drink or be baptized in the same bath of pain as I?" "We can," they told him. Jesus said in response, "From the cup I drink of you shall drink; the bath I am immersed in you shall share. But as for sitting at my right or my left, that is not mine to give, it is for those to whom it has been reserved." The other ten, on hearing this, became indignant at James and John. Jesus called them together and said to them: "You know how among the Gentiles those who seem to exercise authority lord it over them; their great ones make their importance felt. It cannot be like that with you. Anyone among you who aspires to greatness must serve the rest; whoever wants to rank first among you must serve the needs of all. The Son of Man has not come to be served but to serve -- to give his life in ransom for the many."

"Дай нам," ті йому кажуть, "щоб ми сиділи один праворуч, другий ліворуч тебе у твоїй славі." Ісус сказав їм: "Не знаєте, чого просите. Чи можете пити чашу, яку я п'ю, і хреститися хрищенням, яким я хрищуся?" Вони йому відповіли: "Можемо." Ісус сказав їм: "Чашу, яку я п'ю, питимете, і хрищенням, яким я хрищуся, хреститиметесь. Сидіти ж праворуч мене чи ліворуч, не моє дати вам, а кому приготовано." Почули про те десятеро і обурились на Якова та Івана. Тоді Ісус прикликав їх і сказав їм: "Ви знаєте, що ті, яких уважають князями народів, верховодять ними, і їхні вельможі утискають їх. Не так воно хай буде між вами, але хто з-поміж вас хоче бути першим, хай буде рабом усіх. Бо Син Чоловічий не прийшов на те, щоб йому служили, лише щоб служити і віддати своє життя як викуп за багатьох."

WALKING WITH A MOOD OF WONDERMENT WITH JESUS CHRIST

St. Mark tells us of the disciples walking on the road to Jerusalem with Jesus walking in the lead. He tells us that “their mood was one of wonderment, while that of those who followed was fear” (Mk 10:32). Then we hear of two disciples vying to sit, one at the right and the other on the left, when Jesus comes into glory. This caused some anger among the other disciples. Jesus calms them saying, “You know how among the Gentiles those who seem to exercise authority lord it over them; their great ones make their importance felt. It cannot be like that with you. Among you who aspire to greatness must serve the rest; whoever wants to rank first among you must serve the needs of all” (Mk 10:44).

Fear, mutual mistrust, envy, and pride rob you and me of the special gift of walking with Jesus with wonderment. We can be blinded to the needs and sufferings of others around us. We can forget the importance of being of service of others. Great Fast invites you and me to walk alongside Jesus Christ with wonderment as to where He will lead us. We are reminded, “...the Son of Man did not come to be served but to serve...” (Mk 10:45). Saint Tresa of Calcutta saw the face of Jesus in every person she ministered to, especially the sick and the dying. Through her inspiration, may we also cherish and search the opportunities to see Jesus Christ in the faces of those we serve!

Request for Support – Ukrainian Park Cabins Renovation

Dear Reverend Fathers, Grand Knights, and Brother Knights and people of good will!

I am writing to inform you that His Grace, Metropolitan Lawrence, has appointed me as Director of Ukrainian Catholic Children's Camp at Ukrainian Park for this year. My wife, Iryna, will assist me with the organization and administration of the camp.

As we prepare for the upcoming summer season, we have identified several important projects that we hope to complete before the children arrive. These projects aim not only

to improve safety and comfort but also to preserve and strengthen the beautiful legacy entrusted to us by previous generations.

Cabin Renovation Project

As you know, the Knights of Columbus within our Archeparchy have traditionally taken special care of the camp cabins, with some cabins designated to particular councils. We are deeply grateful for this longstanding support.

This year, our renovation wish list for the cabins includes:

- Installation of new flooring,
- Replacement of window and floor casings,
- New windows and doors where needed,
- Interior painting.

Purchase and installation of 4-in-1 air conditioning units (cooling, heating, fan, and dehumidifier).

We recognize that financial resources within councils may be limited, yet we humbly ask that this request be brought to your council meetings for consideration. Any support—financial or practical—will make a meaningful difference.

To acknowledge significant contributions, donations of \$1,000 or more will be recognized with a commemorative plaque installed on a designated cabin.

Our intention is primarily to raise funds for the purchase of materials needed for the renovation. The installation and renovation work itself will be carried out on a volunteer basis. Parishioners from St. Basil's Parish have also committed to helping with installation, painting, and other necessary tasks.

We warmly invite all members of the Knights of Columbus to join us in this renovation effort. Your presence, skills, and fellowship would be deeply appreciated as we work together for the benefit of our children.

Grotto of the Blessed Virgin Mary

The current grotto is in urgent need of replacement, as it is nearly falling apart. This project will be directed toward private donors, sponsors, and business organizations who may wish to contribute to this Marian initiative.

Chapel Updates

We are also planning updates and necessary improvements to the camp chapel. For this project, we intend to seek collaboration and support from the Ukrainian Catholic Women's League of Canada within our Archeparchy.

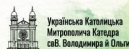

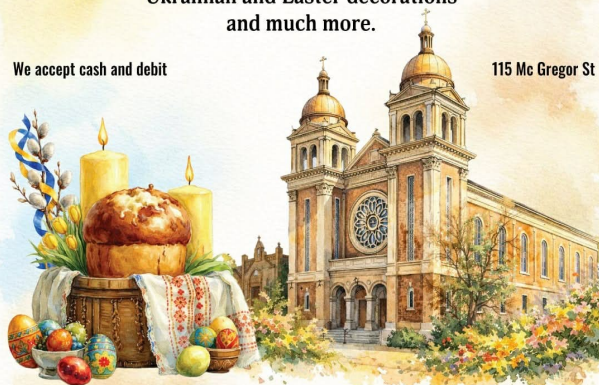

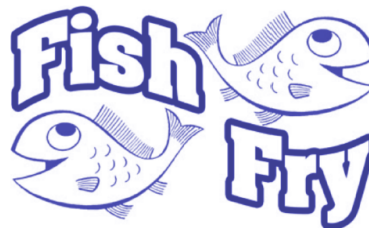

The Great Canon of St. Andrew of Crete

St. Andrew was born around 650 A.D. in Damascus (present-day Syria). Tradition holds that St. Andrew was mute at birth and remained so for his early years. After receiving the Holy Eucharist at age seven, he was miraculously healed by God's grace. He lived and served in Damascus, Constantinople (Hagia Sophia), and Crete. He is recognized as a bishop, theologian, and most notably, a *hymnographer*. Ultimately, he was ordained to a metropolitan see in Crete (Greek Islands) in the late 7th century. It is believed his soul passed to the Lord circa 740 A.D.

Through his work with writing hymns, St. Andrew is credited with introducing a type of hymn called a *canon* (a structured, sung hymn). His masterpiece, *The Great Canon of St. Andrew*, reflects on the soul's repentance, humility, and its challenging journey to fully reunite with God, the Father. In the Ukrainian Greek Catholic tradition, *it is prayed during the fifth week of Great Lent with Matins (often on Wednesday evening)*. This service is lengthy but deeply meaningful! It involves chanting many verses (odes, troparia) and making numerous prostrations (поклони; over 200). The service symbolizes the acts of spiritual and physical penance during Great Lent.

The Great Canon of St. Andrew of Crete and its contents...

Odes: the canon includes variable parts called odes. Most canons have only eight odes, but this penitential canon contains nine full odes. An ode is related to a canticle (hymns based on Old and New Testament Scripture). Each ode follows a basic structure: Irmos, troparia (with refrain), and Katavasia.

Irmos: begins the ode and stands as a sung connection or link between other odes and verses. It can be thought of as a hymn *introducing the theme* of the ode.

Troparia (with refrain): a stanza (verses) of liturgical poetry in different tones followed by a refrain sung by the faithful. The refrain is usually followed by a prostration. The most common refrain we pray is "*Have mercy on me, O God, have mercy on me.*"

Katavasia: sung at the conclusion of an ode. *Summarizes the theme* of the ode.

This Great Canon centers on St. Andrew and his struggles with repentance and transforming his life. It portrays a personal battle between St. Andrew and his eternal soul. St. Andrew realizes how far he has strayed from the grace and love of the Lord and Saviour, Jesus Christ. However, upon this realization, he is pushed further into acts of repentance, aiming to amend his life in honour and love of the Holy Trinity. We are called to follow the example of St. Andrew of Crete and his journey toward salvation. Although this Great Canon is physically demanding, it is primarily a spiritual journey toward a closer union with God, the Father.

"Brief is my lifetime and full of pain and wickedness, but accept me in penitence and call me to the awareness of Thee!" (Ode 4; St. Andrew of Crete)

Glory be to Jesus Christ!

Dear members of the Catholic community,

My name is Liudmyla Ryzhychenko (Myla). I would like to offer a small volunteer initiative for the children of the parish.

I would be happy to organize music and singing lessons for children aged 3–5 on a volunteer basis. For this purpose, I kindly ask for permission to use a room in the church free of charge.

I have a musical background: I graduated from music school, completed vocal training courses, and have many years of experience performing as a solo singer.

The program would be organized in the following way: each child would have one individual lesson per week (25 minutes) for two weeks. On the third week, the children would come together for a group singing session. After that, the cycle would repeat — two weeks of individual lessons followed by a group class.

The program will include Christian children's songs, songs with simple movements, clapping and turns, as well as short recitations. The musical accompaniment will include keyboard instruments as well as children's backing tracks.

If the church wishes and with the parents' permission, the children could present the results of their learning during the children's Sunday liturgy.

In the future, I would also like to organize similar groups for older children (ages 7–9 and 11–13).

I would like to emphasize that this is not a business project but a volunteer initiative, created with the desire to help children grow through music and faith. Let's try for one month!

У майбутньому я також планую відкрити групи для старших дітей (7–9 років та 11–13 років).

Хочу підкреслити, що це не бізнес-проект, а волонтерська ініціатива, створена з бажанням допомагати дітям розвиватися через музику і віру. Спробуймо на один місяць!

Fifth Sunday of Great Lent (Mark 10:32–45)

Today's Gospel shows us a powerful contrast. On the road to Jerusalem, Jesus speaks about His suffering, His Cross, and His sacrifice. But at the same time, the disciples are thinking about honor, power, and greatness.

James and John ask Jesus for places of glory. And how often do we do the same? We want success, recognition, comfort. Yet Jesus gently corrects them—and us.

He says:

“Whoever wants to be great among you must be your servant.”

This is the heart of the Gospel. What do we learn today?

True greatness is not power, but service.

In God's eyes, greatness is measured not by how many people serve us, but by how many we serve.

The way of Christ always passes through the Cross.

There is no Resurrection without sacrifice. There is no glory without humility.

We are called to imitate Christ.

Jesus says: “The Son of Man came not to be served but to serve, and to give His life...”

This is our model—especially during Great Lent.

Today, we are invited to ask ourselves:

Do I seek to be served, or to serve?

Do I avoid the Cross, or do I carry it with Christ?

As we approach Holy Week, let us remember: the path of Christ is the path of humble love, sacrifice, and service.

And in the end, this path leads not to loss—but to true life and Resurrection. Amen.

You have been in church from the beginning of the service, or at least heard the Gospel. To the best of your ability, you are in the state of Grace. ***If for any of these or other reasons you cannot receive Holy Communion, you are welcome to come for a blessing. Please indicate to the priest that you would like to receive his blessing. For those who are divorced and living common-law the Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist cannot be received. You are welcome to come for a blessing. (If you are divorced with a Church annulment, and remarried in the Church you are more than welcome to receive the Holy Sacraments.)***
