May the Lord bless you and your families with health, peace, and abundant graces. With prayers and gratitude,

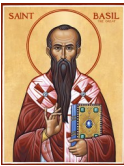

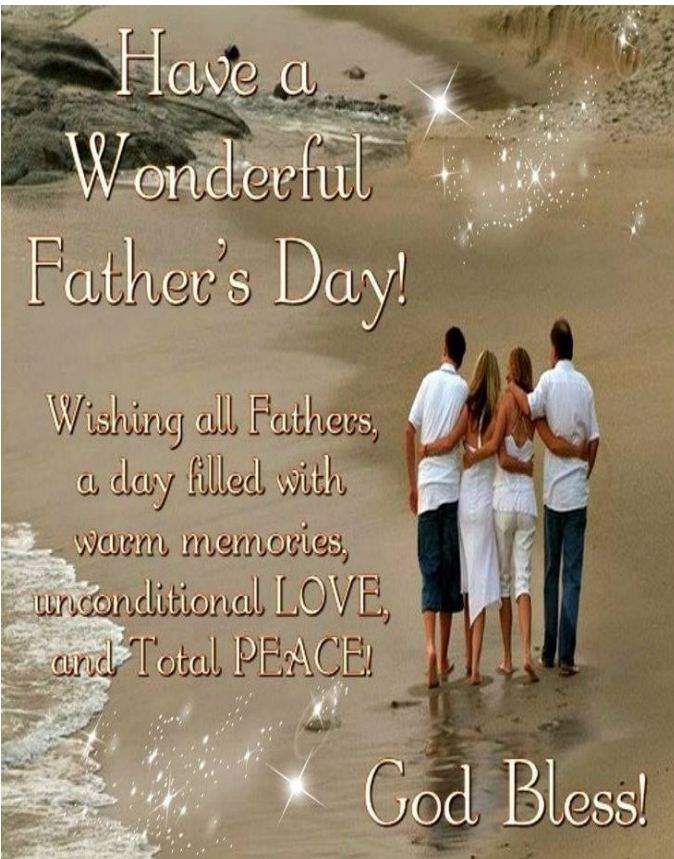

When you were slaves of sin, you had freedom from justice. What benefit did you then enjoy? Things you are now ashamed of, all of them tending toward death. But now that you are freed from sin and have become slaves of God, your benefit is sanctification as you tend toward eternal life. The wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.**

**Gospel: Matthew 8: 5 - 13** At that time as Jesus entered Capernaum, a centurion approached him with this request: “Sir, my serving boy is at home in bed paralyzed, suffering painfully.” He said to him, “I will come and cure him.” “Sir,” the centurion said in reply, “I am not worthy to have you under my roof. Just give an order and my boy will get better. I am a man under authority myself and I have troops assigned to me. If I give one man the order, ‘Dismissed,’ off he goes. If I say to another, ‘Come here,’ he comes. If I tell my slave, ‘Do this,’ he does it.” Jesus showed amazement on hearing this and remarked to his followers, “I assure you, I have never found this much faith in Israel. Mark what I say! Many will come from the east and the west and will find a place at the banquet in the kingdom of God with Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, while the natural heirs of the kingdom will be driven out into the dark. Wailing will be heard there, and the grinding of teeth.” To the centurion Jesus said, “Go home. It shall be done because you trusted.” That very moment the boy got better.

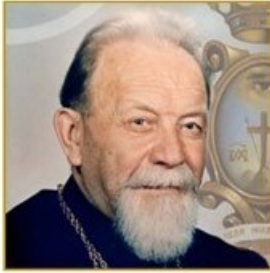

## **A TIME TO SHARE OUR FAITH WITH OTHER CHRISTIAN DENOMINATIONS**

On Tuesday, June 16, 2026, St. Basil the Great Ukrainian Catholic Parish had the honour and privilege of celebrating the Divine Liturgy in the presence of members of the *Ecumenical Dialogue with the Lutheran Church and the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops (CCCC)*. Fr. Mykhaylo Khomitsky served as the main celebrant, and attendees included Lutheran clergy and religious, as well as Most Reverend Gerard Bergie, Catholic Bishop of St. Catharines, ON. St. Basil's was also blessed to have Subdeacon Dr. Brian Butcher, who arranged the event and assisted in the celebration of the Divine Liturgy.

From a Christian perspective, **ecumenism** is the promotion of cooperation, unity, and dialogue among all Christians. As Catholics, we believe that Jesus Christ established *one true Church* on earth, with St. Peter as 'the rock' upon which this Church will be built (Matthew 7:24-25 and Matthew 16:16-19; *apostolic tradition*). Over the past 2000 years since Jesus Christ's earthly ministry, Christian denominations have split from the Catholic Church for many reasons, motives, and tensions. Yet the promotion of ecumenism within the Catholic Church was strongly encouraged by the Second Vatican Council (1962-1964 AD), convoked by Pope John XIII (died June 3, 1963 AD) and continued by Pope Paul VI. **Dialogue**, a vital part of ecumenism, between Christians and other non-Christian religions (encyclicals: *Ecclesiam Suam*, *Unitatis Redintegratio*, *Nostrae Aetate*, *Gaudium et Spes*) has been, and remains, a major focal point of the Catholic Church in the modern world.

Although there are many forms of dialogue, St. Basil's Parish was fortunate to share our Ukrainian Greek Catholic Faith not only with other Catholics but also with other Christians (Lutherans) through the celebration and consecration of the Holy Eucharist. Members of other churches witnessed the beauty of our tradition and faith. In common prayer, unity among baptized Christians (regardless of denomination, doctrine, or practice) was strengthened as we, through our baptism, have all been sealed with and in Jesus Christ!

It is important for dialogue to continue with other Christians and non-Christians! Although we Catholics must stand firm in our beliefs, traditions, and faith, our Christian nature requires us to be respectful and open, and to listen with understanding not only to other Christians but also to humanity as a whole. If dialogue ceases, the 'waters of understanding' become stagnant and polluted. Dialogue keeps the waters flowing and fresh, therefore bringing us all into a greater union, not only amongst ourselves but also with God the Father, His Son, Jesus Christ, and the Holy Spirit.

As Pope Francis once said, "*Often we think that ecumenical work is only that of theologians. It is therefore important that theologians study, they agree, and they express their disagreement: this is very important. But in the meantime ecumenism journeys on. It journeys with Jesus, not 'my Jesus against your Jesus', but with our Jesus. The journey is simple: it consists of prayer, with the help of others. Praying together: the ecumenism of prayer, for each other and all for unity. And then, the ecumenism of work for the many who are in need, for many men and women who today suffer as a result of injustice, wars, these terrible things. ... All together, we must help. Love for our neighbour. This is ecumenism. This is already unity. **Unity in journeying with Jesus.**"* - Address to the Christian World Communions delegation, Oct. 12, 2016

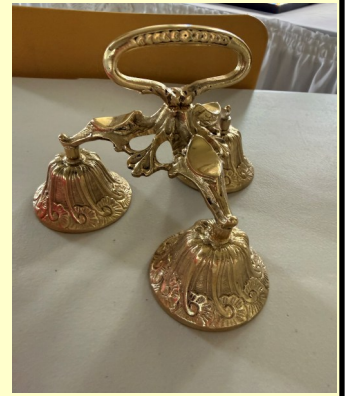

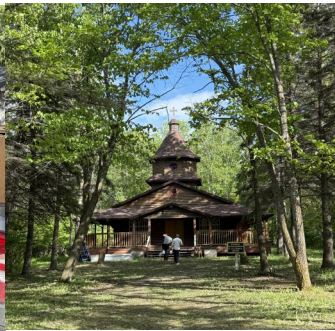

We extend our heartfelt gratitude to the anonymous donor whose kindness made this possible. May God reward this generosity a hundredfold and bless all those who continue to support those in need.

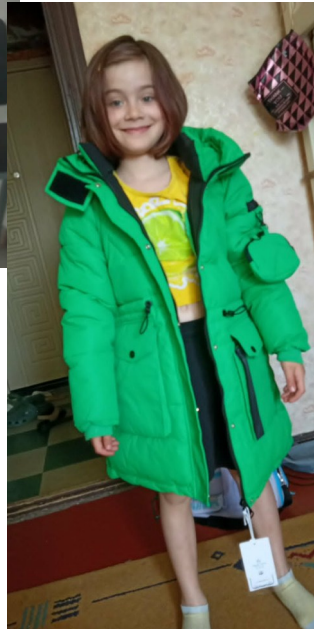
As Jesus reminds us, faith is not meant to remain only in words. True faith is expressed through acts of love and mercy. As the Apostle James teaches:

## **BY STRIKING THE KYIV-PECHERSK LAVRA, RUSSIA SHOWS THAT IT IS NOT RUS', AND KYIV IS NOT RUSSIAN TERRITORY, SAYS HEAD OF THE UGCC, JUNE 16, 2026**

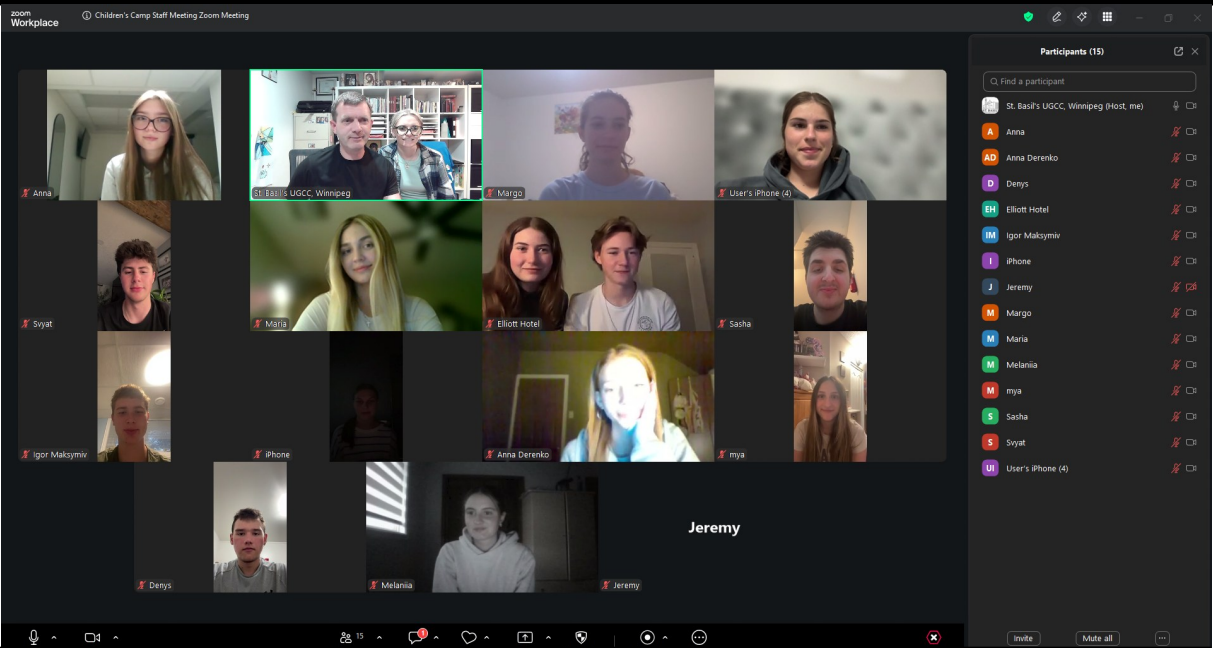
Indeed, when the Lord God intends to punish someone, He deprives that person of sound judgement. By this attack, the Russian aggressor has shown that Russia is not Rus'; Kyiv is not Russian territory; and the history of the Kyiv-Pechersk tradition of holiness is not the history of Moscow's piety. His Beatitude Sviatoslav, Father and Head of the Ukrainian Greek Catholic Church, spoke about this on June 16 at the Mykhailo Drahomanov National University of Ukraine during the ceremony in which he was awarded the honorary title of Doctor Honoris Causa.

**"We are all still overwhelmed by these emotions, by the shock felt throughout the cultural world following Sunday's Russian drone strike and the fire at the Cathedral of the Dormition of the Kyiv-Pechersk Lavra. The whole world has condemned the attack as yet another crime against humanity," SAID HIS BEATITUDE SVIATOSLAV.**

He drew attention to one historical detail: "This Sunday we celebrated the Feast of All Saints of the Ukrainian People, all the ascetics of the Kyiv Church, from our baptizers Volodymyr and Olha, the saints of the Kyiv-Pechersk Lavra, all the way to the heroes of the Christian faith of our day. Interestingly, on this very same day, the Moscow Church celebrated the feast of 'All Saints Who Shone Forth in the Russian Land.' How ironic—on this very day, a barbaric hand launched a fiery attack on the church consecrated in honor of the Dormition of the Mother of God at the Kyiv-Pechersk Lavra. With this act, they have forever cut themselves off from Kyiv Christianity."

### Basic Guidelines for Reception of Holy Communion

You are a member of the Catholic Church; You have participated in the Sacrament of Confession at least during the Easter or Christmas seasons this past year if not more frequently; You attend Divine Services regularly; Your lifestyle is consistent with the teaching of the Catholic Church; You have kept the Liturgical fast – no food at least one hour prior to the Divine Liturgy (water and medicine does not break the fast). You have been in church from the beginning of the service, or at least heard the Gospel. To the best of your ability, you are in the state of Grace. ***If for any of these or other reasons you cannot receive Holy Communion, you are welcome to come for a blessing. Please indicate to the priest that you would like to receive his blessing. For those who are divorced and living common-law the Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist cannot be received. You are welcome to come for a blessing. (If you are divorced with a Church annulment, and remarried in the Church you are more than welcome to receive the Holy Sacraments.)***

Your pastor may have no other way of knowing that you are in hospital, as per privacy legislation.**
