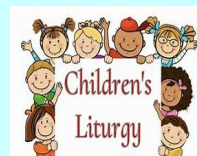

Tropar, tone 7: By Your cross You destroyed death;* You opened Paradise to the thief;* You changed the lamentation of the myrrh-bearers to joy,* and charged the apostles to proclaim* that You are risen, O Christ, our God,* offering great mercy to the world.

Glorify be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, now and for ever and ever. Amen.

Kondak, tone 7: No longer shall the dominion of death be able to hold humanity,* for Christ went down shattering and destroying its powers.* Hades is bound.* The prophets exult with one voice.* The Savior has come for those with faith, saying:* “Come forth, O faithful, to the resurrection!”

Prokimen, tone 7: The Lord will give strength to His people; the Lord will bless His people with peace.

Verse: Bring to the Lord, O you sons of God; bring to the Lord young rams.

Epistle: A reading from the Epistle to the Hebrews. (13: 7 – 16) Brothers and Sisters! Remember your leaders who spoke the word of God to you; consider how their lives ended, and imitate their faith. Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever. Do not be carried away by all kinds of strange teaching. It is good to have our hearts strengthened by the grace of God and not by foods which are useless to those who take them as a standard for living. We have an altar from which those who serve the tabernacle have no right to eat. The bodies of the animals whose blood is brought into the sanctuary by the high priest as a sin offering are burned outside the camp. Therefore Jesus died outside the gate, to sanctify the people by his own blood. Let us go to him outside the camp, bearing the insult which he bore. For here we have no lasting city; we are seeking one which is to come. Through him let us continually offer God a sacrifice of praise, that is, the fruit of lips which acknowledge his name. Do not neglect good deeds and generosity, God is pleased by sacrifices of that kind.

Alleluia Verses: It is good to give praise to the Lord; and to sing in Your name, O Most High.

To announce Your mercy in the morning and Your truth every night.

Gospel: John 17:1-13 At that time Jesus looked up to heaven and said: "Father, the hour has come! Give glory to your Son that your Son may give glory to you, inasmuch as you have given him authority over all mankind, that he may bestow eternal life on those you gave him. Eternal life is this, to know you, the only true God, and him whom you have sent, Jesus Christ. I have given you glory on earth by finishing the work you gave me to do. Do you now, Father, give me glory at your side, a glory I had with you before the world began. I have made your name known to those you gave me out of the world. These men you gave me were yours; they have kept your word. Now they realize that all that you gave me comes from you. I entrusted to them the message you entrusted to me and they received it. They have known that in truth I came from you, they have believed it was you who sent me. For these I pray -- not for the world but for these you have given me, for they are really yours. Just as all that belongs to me is yours, so all that belongs to you is mine. It is in them that I have been glorified. I am in the world no more, but these are in the world as I come to you. O Father most holy, protect them with your name which you have given me, that they may be one, even as we are one. As long as I was with them, I guarded them with your name which you gave me. I kept careful watch, and not one of them was lost, none but him who was destined to be lost -- in fulfillment of Scripture. Now, however, I come to you; I say all this while I am still in the world that they may share my joy completely.

Pope Leo XIV Appoints Most Rev. Michael Kwiatkowski as New Metropolitan Archbishop of Winnipeg July 9, 2026



WINNIPEG — The Ukrainian Catholic Bishops in Canada are pleased to share the announcement made by the Vatican Press Service on Thursday, 9 July 2026, that His Holiness Pope Leo XIV has accepted the resignation of the Most Rev. Lawrence Huculak, O.S.B.M., Metropolitan Archbishop of the Ukrainian Catholic Archeparchy of Winnipeg, upon his reaching the age of 75. Concurrently, His Holiness appointed the Most Rev. Michael Kwiatkowski, heretofore the Bishop of the Ukrainian Catholic Eparchy of New West-

minster, as the new Metropolitan Archbishop of the Ukrainian Catholic Archeparchy of Winnipeg. The date of his installation will be announced as soon as it is determined.

The nomination of Bishop Michael to serve as the sixth bishop and fourth Metropolitan Archbishop of the Winnipeg See was proposed by the Synod of Bishops of the Ukrainian Catholic Church and subsequently accepted and confirmed by His Holiness Pope Leo XIV. Bishop Michael Kwiatkowski, who was ordained a priest in

1986 by Metropolitan Maxim Hermaniuk, C.Ss.R., for the Archeparchy of Winnipeg, has served in various parishes in Manitoba, England, Italy, and Ukraine. He has also served as Secretary and Chancellor within the Archeparchy, as well as Chancellor of the Patriarchal Curia of the UGCC, Judge and Head of the Patriarchal Tribunal, and Head of the Patriarchal Catechetical Commission. Additionally, he served for six years as Vice-Rector and lecturer in canon law at the Ukrainian Catholic University in Ukraine. Three years ago, the Most Rev. Michael Kwiatkowski was appointed by Pope Francis as the fourth Bishop of the Eparchy of New Westminster on Canada's West Coast. He was consecrated a bishop at Sts. Volodymyr & Olha Cathedral in Winnipeg by Metropolitan Lawrence Huculak, Metropolitan Borys Gudziak of Philadelphia, and Bishop David Motiuk of Edmonton on 8 November 2023, and was installed at Holy Eucharist Cathedral in New Westminster later that month on 18 November 2023.

Bishop Michael very much enjoyed working with the clergy of the Eparchy of New Westminster and serving the faithful of that eparchy, which officially spans British Columbia, the Yukon, and a portion of the Northwest Territories. He will greatly miss them. However, he is determined to keep them and his successor in his prayers and to continue to assist in any way possible.

Папа Лев XIV призначив Високопреосвященнішого Владику Михайла Квятковського новим Архієпископом і Митрополитом Вінніпезьким

9 липня 2026 року

ВІННІПЕГ — Українські католицькі єпископи Канади з радістю повідомляють про оголошення пресслужби Ватикану у четвер, 9 липня 2026 року, згідно з яким Його Святістю Папа Лев XIV прийняв зречення з уряду Високопреосвященнішого владика Лаврентія Гуцуляка, ЧСВВ, Архієпископа і Митрополита Вінніпезької Української Католицької Архієпархії, у зв'язку з досягненням ним 75-річного віку. Водночас Святійший Отець призначив Високопреосвященнішого владика Михайла Квятковського, який до цього часу обіймав посаду

Єпископа Нью-Вестмінстерської Української Католицької єпархії, новим Архієпископом і Митрополитом Вінніпезької Української Католицької Архієпархії. Дата його інтронізації буде оголошена пізніше.

Номінація владика Михайла на служіння шостим єпископом і четвертим Митрополитом-Архієпископом Вінніпезького престолу була запропонована Синодом Єпископів Української Католицької Церкви, а згодом прийнята і затверджена Його Святістю Папою Левом XIV.

Владика Михайло Квятковський, який у 1986 році був висвячений на священника Митрополитом Максимом Германюком, ЧНІ, для Вінніпезької Архієпархії, служив у різних парафіях у Манітобі, Англії, Італії та Україні. Він також виконував обов'язки секретаря та канцлера в Архієпархії, а також канцлера Патріаршої курії УГКЦ, судді та голови Патріаршого трибуналу й голови Патріаршої катехитичної комісії. Окрім того, протягом шести років він служив віцеканцлером та викладачем канонічного права в Українському католицькому університеті в Україні.

Три роки тому Преосвященніший владика Михайло Квятковський був призначений Папою Франциском четвертим Єпископом Нью-Вестмінстерської єпархії на західному узбережжі Канади. Його єпископська хіротонія відбулася в катедральному соборі святих Володимира і Ольги у Вінніпезі 8 листопада 2023 року за участю Митрополита Лаврентія Гуцуляка, Митрополита Бориса Гудзяка з Філадельфії та владик Давида Мотюка з Едмонтона, а чин його інтронізації відбувся в катедральному соборі Пресвятої Євхаристії в Нью-Вестмінстері наприкінці того ж місяця, 18

листопада 2023 року.

Владика Михайло мав велику радість співпрацювати з духовенством Нью-Вестмінстерської єпархії та служити вірним цієї єпархії, яка офіційно охоплює Британську Колумбію, Юкон та частину Північно-Західних територій. Йому дуже бракуватиме їх. Проте він твердо налаштований повсякчас згадувати їх та свого наступника у своїх молитвах і надалі всіляко допомагати.

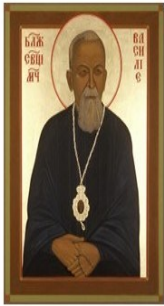

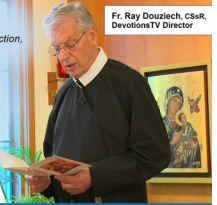

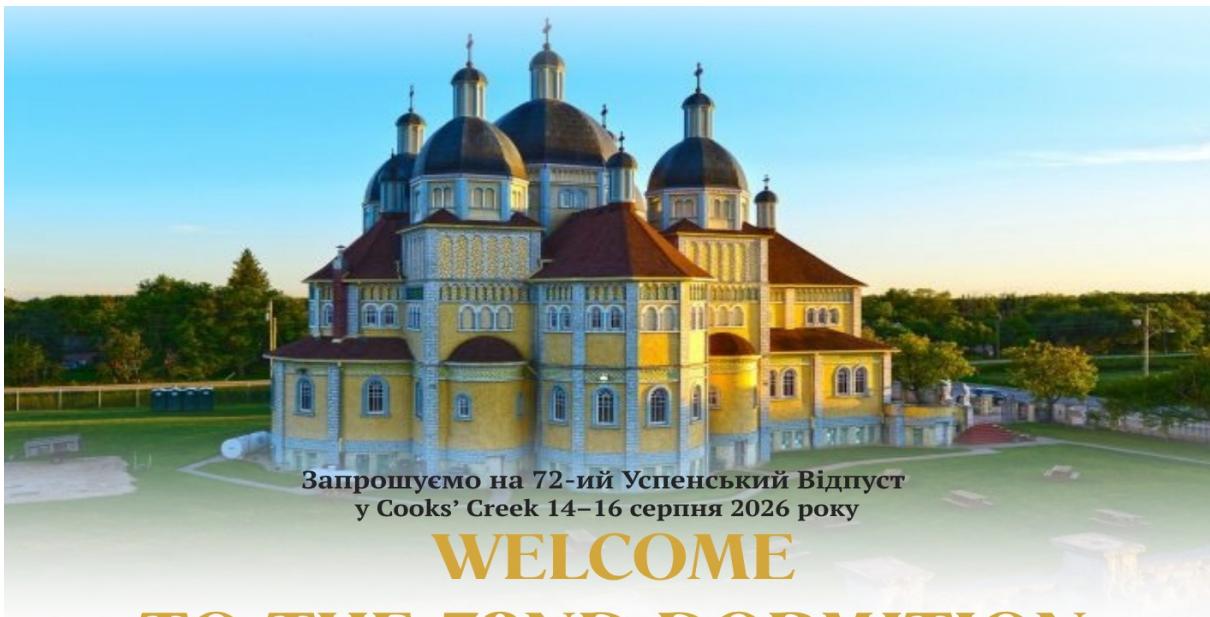

«Follow me!» (Mark 2:14): Vocations to priestly ministry and consecrated life in the contemporary world

Pastoral Letter of the 2026 Synod of Bishops of the Ukrainian Greek-Catholic Church

To Parents, Youth, Clergy and Religious, To Lay Faithful of the UGCC in Ukraine and Abroad, and to all People of Good Will BA 26/282 ENG And I heard the voice of the Lord saying, «Whom shall I send, and who will go for us?» Then I said, «Here am I! Send me.» Isaiah 6:8

Beloved in Christ! Having gathered at this year's Synod of Bishops of the UGCC at the Marian Pilgrimage Center in Zarvanytsia, with a sense of pastoral responsibility for the good of the flock entrusted to us, we devoted special attention to the topic «Vocations Ministry to the Priesthood and Monasticism.»

In Christian understanding, a vocation is not a profession, but an identity that arises in response to Christ's call to discipleship. In the broader sense, every Christian has his or her own vocation — to bear witness to God's love in the world according to one's age and state of life, journeying on the path to salvation, growing in faith, holiness, and love. At the same time, some are called to a particular ministry: «Follow me, and I will make you fishers of men» (Matthew 4:19). Most often, such a vocation is fulfilled in the priestly ministry or consecrated life. Throughout the history of our Church, the Lord has constantly sent fervent laborers into His harvest. The call of Christ once led Anthony and Theodosius, the founders of Ukrainian monasticism, to the caves of Kyiv. It was a guide for Count Roman Sheptytsky, who became metropolitan and oversaw the spiritual revival of our Church and people in the 20th century. During the times of the atheistic regime, at the Lord's call young seekers of Divine truth went underground in order to preserve the spark of hope and the light of faith amidst darkness, evil, and falsehood. Subsequently, by Divine blessing, when our Church emerged from the underground, a large number of young men and women responded to the Lord's special inner call, «Follow me,» and entered the reestablished seminaries, monasteries, and communities of consecrated life.

The Holy Spirit always fills the Church with laborers in His vineyard, even in difficult, trying times. All that is needed is for us to be open to the gift of vocation, desire this gift, and constantly pray for it: «The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few; therefore pray earnestly to the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into his harvest.» (Matthew 9:37–38). So, with gratitude to those who have already responded to the Lord's call, we encourage all of you, dear brothers and sisters, to a prayerful openness to this gift from God.

Dear young men and women! You might ask yourself: «How does God call one to ministry in the Church?» A vocation is most often engendered early in life, when a child experiences God's goodness and love, and begins to understand how important that is for his or her life. The Lord calls through participation in the church community, especially in the Christian family as a «domestic Church» and in the local parish community. The Lord calls with His word through listening to and reading the Holy Scriptures. The Lord speaks in the liturgical life of the Church through the Holy Mysteries-Sacraments, especially in Holy Confession, and in the silence of personal prayer. The Lord calls by using people who, with their holy, joyful and God-pleasing lives, grant others the opportunity to know Him and encourage others to follow Him.

A vocation in the Church is a great gift and also a great responsibility! It requires openness, a spirit of listening, inner sensitivity and an ability to discern God's call in the depths of the heart. In order to be able to properly receive this call, one must cultivate a love for Christ and for the Church, a readiness to be an instrument in God's hands, an openness to various kinds of ministries in the Church. We encourage you to pray and work on personal growth, practice the virtues, in word and deed help others to be close to Christ. Actively participate in Christian youth communities. When you experience various crises in your personal, family, or social life,

especially amid the trials of the current war, cultivate a personal friendship with the Lord Jesus, seeking from Him support, comfort, and guidance for your life. May you be aided in this through a prayerful closeness to His Most Holy Mother, who is a model of openness to the gift of vocation: «Behold, I am the handmaid of the Lord; let it be to me according to your word» (Luke 1:38).

Dear parents! Thanking you for your service, we encourage you to live the fullness of Christian life in your families. Treat your children with the understanding that they are God's children, entrusted to your care. Pray with them every day and together with them take an active part in the life of the Church. Support your children's desire to serve God and the Church. Be for them a living image of God's love. By your example, teach your children to be sacrificial and generous, and to rely on God's grace. Open up for your children the greatness of ministry in the Church and be assured that the parents of a priest, monk, or nun have a special honor in the Church, as those who blessed their children to offer their lives to God.

Dear parish priests! Together with your parish communities you fulfill a special task in vocations ministry—that of recognizing the action of the Holy Spirit in the hearts of your youngest parishioners. That is why it is so important for you to support the vocation of a young person by listening attentively, encouraging, and supporting. Your personal example of a pious life and a ministry fulfilled with joy and zeal in a spirit of self-sacrifice encourages a young person to follow in your footsteps.

Quite often a young person's vocation dies out only because no one paid attention to it in due time and never supported it. Nurture vocations by inviting children and young people to actively participate in church services. Meet with young people regularly. Organize pilgrimages and summer camps for them. Invite seminarians, priests and consecrated persons to events organized for children and youth. Above all, pray for vocations together with the entire parish community. If vocations to priestly ministry or consecrated life have emerged from your parish, let young people know about it. Invite these individuals so that they can bear witness to their personal vocation journey in their mother parish.

Dear fathers, brothers and sisters in communities of consecrated life! Be present in the lives of our youth. May the joy of your vocation be visible to all in your words and deeds. Cultivate the evangelical virtues—poverty, chastity, and obedience, living together in a community that is a model of Christian brotherhood, sisterhood, and cooperation for the good of the Church of Christ and for the sanctification of the People of God. Practice spiritual accompaniment—fatherhood and motherhood—both in your own communities as well as towards those who come to your homes seeking support, healing, or assistance.

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ! Know that vocations to priestly ministry and consecrated life are a sign of the vitality of the Church. Indeed, she unceasingly gives birth to new workers in Christ's vineyard. A Vibrant Parish is a place where a young person can encounter the living Christ and hear his call: «Follow me!» An authentic «domestic Church» is a family community that creates all the conditions for the seedling of a vocation to grow to maturity. Therefore, let us all foster this great gift together, and let us accompany those who are called with our prayers.

May the blessing of Almighty God, the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit, descend upon every young person, upon his or her parents, upon priests, monks, nuns, upon each of our parish communities and our entire people, and be with all of us always!

Basic Guidelines for Reception of Holy Communion

You are a member of the Catholic Church; You have participated in the Sacrament of Confession at least during the Easter or Christmas seasons this past year if not more frequently;

You attend Divine Services regularly; Your lifestyle is consistent with the teaching of the Catholic Church; You have kept the Liturgical fast – no food at least one hour prior to the Divine Liturgy (water and medicine does not break the fast). You have been in church from the beginning of the service, or at least heard the Gospel. To the best of your ability, you are in the state of Grace. ***If for any of these or other reasons you cannot receive Holy Communion, you are welcome to come for a blessing. Please indicate to the priest that you would like to receive his blessing.*** For those who are divorced and living common-law the Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist cannot be received. You are welcome to come for a blessing. (If you are divorced with a Church annulment, and remarried in the Church you are more than welcome to receive the Holy Sacraments.)
