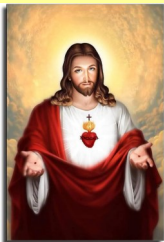

Sunday Tropar, tone 5: Let us the faithful acclaim and worship the Word,* co-eternal with the Father and the Spirit,* and born of the Virgin for our salvation.* For He willed to be lifted up on the cross in the flesh,* to suffer death and to raise the dead* by His glorious resurrection.

Tropar of the Feast, tone 7: O Virgin Mother of God,* your glory we celebrate,* your help we seek,* your miraculous icon we venerate.* You are our gracious Mother,* you are the Hope of the world.* Do not despise our prayers,* but always rescue us from our sorrows and troubles.

Glory be to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit.

Kondak of the Feast, tone 6: Our Mother of Perpetual Help,* grant us, we pray, help in difficulties, relief in sickness,* comfort in sorrow, strength in our labours.* Give us, we beseech you, the virtue of piety, unity to Christians,* forgiveness to sinners, perseverance to the righteous,* salvation to the dying, purification to the souls in purgatory* and obtain for them eternal glory.

Sunday Kondak, tone 5: You, my Savior, descended to Hades,* and as the Almighty, You shattered its gates.* With Yourself You, as the Creator, raised the dead and shattered the sting of death,* and delivered Adam from the curse, O Lover of Mankind.* And so we cry out: "Save us, O Lord."

Prokimen, tone 5: You, O Lord, will guard us and will keep us from this generation, and for ever.

Verse: Save me, O Lord, for there is no longer left a just man.

Epistle: A reading from the Letter of the Holy Apostle Paul to the Romans. (12: 6 - 14)

Brothers and Sisters! We have gifts that differ according to the favor bestowed on each of us. One's gift may be prophecy; its use should be in proportion to his faith. It may be the gift of ministry; it should be used for service. One who is a teacher should use his gift for teaching; one with the power of exhortation, should exhort. He who gives alms should do so generously; he who rules should exercise his authority with care; he who performs works of mercy should do so cheerfully. Your love must be sincere. Detest what is evil, cling to what is good. Love one another with the affection of brothers. Anticipate each other in showing respect. Do not grow slack but be fervent in spirit; he whom you serve is the Lord. Rejoice in hope, be patient under trial, persevere in prayer. Look on the needs of the saints as your own; be generous in offering hospitality. Bless your persecutors; bless and do not curse them.

Alleluia Verses: Your mercies, O Lord, I will sing for ever; from generation to generation I will announce Your truth with my mouth. For You have said: Mercy shall be built up for ever; in the heavens Your truth shall be prepared.

Gospel: Matthew 9: 1 - 8 At that time Jesus reentered the boat, made the crossing, and came back to his own town. There the people at once brought to him a paralyzed man lying on a mat. When Jesus saw their faith he said to the paralytic, "Have courage, son, your sins are forgiven." At that some of the scribes said to themselves, "The man blasphemes." Jesus was aware of what they were thinking and said: "Why do you harbor evil thoughts? Which is less trouble to say, 'Your sins are forgiven' or 'Stand up and walk'? To help you realize that the Son of Man has authority on earth to forgive sins" -- he then said to the paralyzed man -- "Stand up! Roll up your mat, and go home." The man stood up and went toward his home. At the sight, a feeling of awe came over the crowd, and they praised God for giving such authority to men. O my soul, extol the Mother of God*, of Perpetual Help.* Beneath the Cross we heard the words of comfort,* that you are our Mother and we are your children.* Therefore, we have gathered today and sincerely plea:* Place our Church and our nation under Your perpetual help,* for we extol you with faith and love,* as our

Mother of Perpetual Help.

THE OLDEST IS 77, THE YOUNGEST 44: WORKING SESSIONS OF THE SYNOD OF BISHOPS OF THE UKRAINIAN GREEK CATHOLIC CHURCH BEGIN IN ZARVANYTSIA (JULY 1, 2026)

On July 1, the working sessions of the Synod of Bishops of the Ukrainian Greek Catholic Church began at the Marian Spiritual Center “Zarvanytsia.”

They will continue until July 10.

The first session began at 9:00 a.m. with a prayer offered by the bishops for Ukraine’s fallen defenders and the innocent victims of the war. This was

followed by the official opening of the working sessions, including a welcome to those present, the introduction of guests and Synod officials, confirmation of a quorum for subsequent votes, and the adoption of the schedule and agenda for the Synod’s working sessions.

The Synod of Bishops of the Ukrainian Greek Catholic Church Begins Today: His Beatitude Sviatoslav Calls for More Fervent Prayer

Forty-nine bishops of the Ukrainian Greek Catholic Church from Ukraine, Central and Western Europe, North and South America, and Australia are participating in the 2026 Synod of Bishops of the UGCC. They include 34 ruling bishops, 1 bishop of the Patriarchal Curia, 9 auxiliary bishops, and 5 emeritus bishops.



The oldest participant in the Synod’s working sessions is 77-year-old Bishop Mykhailo Koltun, retired bishop of the Sokal-Zhovkva Eparchy. The youngest is 44-year-old Auxiliary Bishop Mykola Semenyshyn of the Ivano-Frankivsk Archeparchy.

Over the past year, the following changes have taken place in the Synod of Bishops of the UGCC:

On August 13, 2025, in Winnipeg, Canada, Bishop Peter Stasiuk, retired bishop for Ukrainians in Australia, New Zealand, and Oceania, passed into eternity. He was buried on October 1 at the Cathedral of Sts. Peter and Paul in Melbourne.

On September 13, 2025, Bishop Mariusz Dmyterko was consecrated as Auxiliary Bishop of the Wroclaw-Koszalin Eparchy.

On December 18, 2025, Bishop Hlib Lonchyna retired as Apostolic Administrator of the Paris Eparchy of St. Volodymyr the Great.

On December 18, 2025, Bishop Ihor Rantsya was consecrated as Bishop of the Paris Eparchy of St. Volodymyr the Great.

The main theme of the 2026 Synod of Bishops of the Ukrainian Greek Catholic Church is “Pastoral Care of Vocations to the Priesthood and Religious Life.” During the plenary sessions, the bishops will analyze the current state of vocations in different parts of the world, discuss the experiences of their eparchies, and seek common responses to the challenges facing the Church as a result of war, migration, and social change. Particular emphasis will be placed on creating an environment in which young people can hear God’s voice, discern their vocation, and receive appropriate spiritual guidance on their journey toward the priesthood or consecrated life.

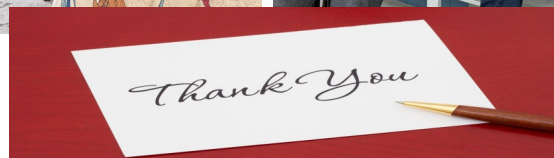

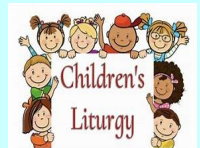

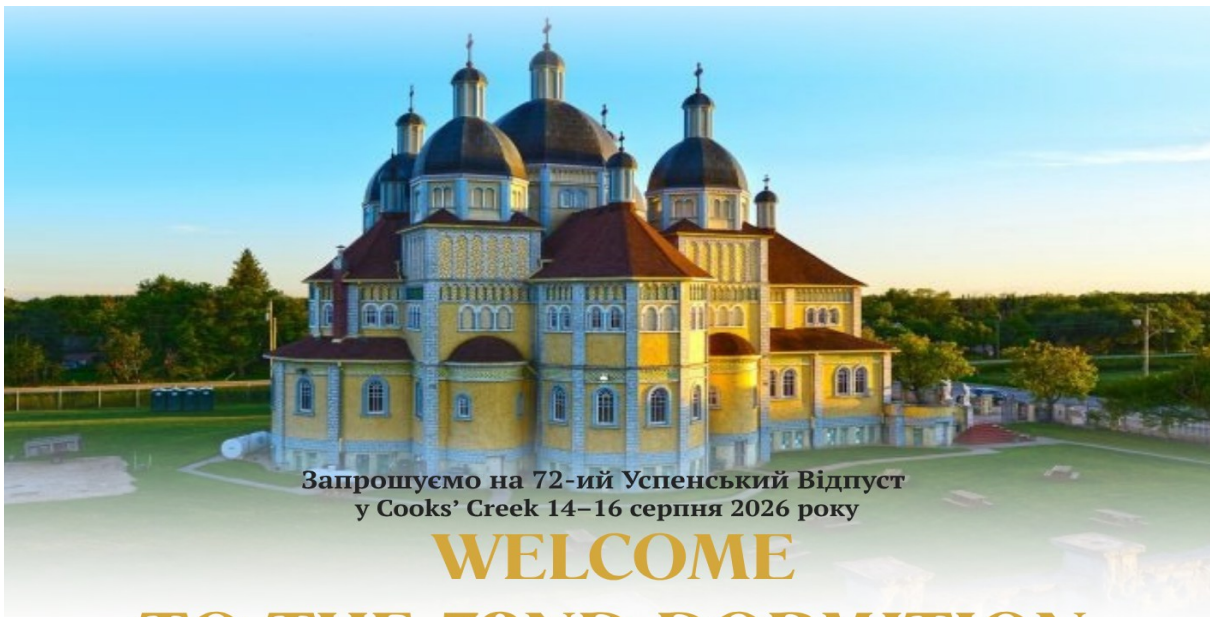

Basic Guidelines for Reception of Holy Communion

You are a member of the Catholic Church; You have participated in the Sacrament of Confession at least during the Easter or Christmas seasons this past year if not more frequently;

You attend Divine Services regularly; Your lifestyle is consistent with the teaching of the Catholic Church; You have kept the Liturgical fast – no food at least one hour prior to the Divine Liturgy (water and medicine does not break the fast). You have been in church from the beginning of the service, or at least heard the Gospel. To the best of your ability, you are in the state of Grace. ***If for any of these or other reasons you cannot receive Holy Communion, you are welcome to come for a blessing. Please indicate to the priest that you would like to receive his blessing. For those who are divorced and living common-law the Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist cannot be received. You are welcome to come for a blessing. (If you are divorced with a Church annulment, and remarried in the Church you are more than welcome to receive the Holy Sacraments.)***
