У середу до нас приєднається Владика Андрій, який помолитиметься з нами Божественну Літургію, тож усі щиро запрошені до спільної молитви.

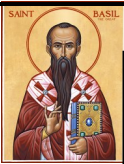

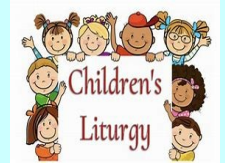

Sunday, August 16 12th Sunday after Pentecost/Post-feast of Dormition of B.V.M.

Sunday Tropar, tone 3: Let the heavens be glad, let the earth rejoice, for the Lord has done a mighty deed with His arm.* He trampled death by death; He became the first born of the dead;* He saved us from the abyss of Hades* and granted great mercy to the world.

Festive Tropar, tone 1: O Mother of God, in giving birth you still preserved virginity; and in your falling asleep you did not forsake the world.* You are the Mother of Life and have been transferred to life,* and through your prayers have delivered our souls from death.

Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, now and for ever and ever. Amen.

Sunday Kondak, tone 3: You rose from the tomb, O compassionate Lord, and led us out from the gates of death. Today Adam exults and Eve rejoices, and the prophets together with the patriarchs unceasingly acclaim the divine might of Your power.

Prokimen, tone 3: Sing to our God, sing; sing to our King, sing.

Verse: Clap your hands, all you nations; shout unto God with the voice of joy.

Epistle: A reading from the First Letter of the Holy Apostle Paul to the Corinthians. (15: 1 - 11)

Brothers and Sisters! I want to remind you of the gospel I preached to you, which you received and in which you stand firm. You are being saved by it at this very moment if you hold fast to it as I preached it to you. Otherwise you have believed in vain. I handed on to you first of all what I myself received that Christ died for our sins in accordance with the Scriptures; that he was buried and, in accordance with the Scriptures, rose on the third day; that he was seen by Cephas, then by the Twelve. After that he was seen by five hundred brothers at once, most of whom are still alive, although some have fallen asleep. Next he was seen by James; then by all the apostles. Last of all he was seen by me, as one born out of the normal course. I am the least of the apostles; in fact, because I persecuted the church of God, I do not even deserve the name. But by God's favor I am what I am. This favor of his to me has not proved fruitless. Indeed, I have worked harder than all the others, not on my own but through the favor of God. In any case, whether it be I or they, this is what we preach and this is what you believed.

Alleluia Verses: In You, O Lord, have I hoped that I may not be put to shame for ever. Be a protector unto me, O God, and a house of refuge to save me.

Gospel: Matthew 19: 16 - 26 At that time a young man came up to him and said, "Teacher, what good must I do to possess everlasting life?" He answered, "Why do you question me about what is good? There is One who is good. If you wish to enter into life, keep the commandments."

"Which ones?" he asked. Jesus replied, " 'You shall not kill'; 'You shall not commit adultery'; 'You shall not steal'; 'You shall not bear false witness'; 'Honor your father and your mother'; and 'Love your neighbour as yourself.' " The young man said to him, "I have kept all these; what do I need to do further?" Jesus told him, "If you seek perfection, go, sell your possessions, and give to the poor. You will then have treasure in heaven. Afterward, come back and follow me." Hearing these words, the young man went away sad, for his possessions were many. Jesus said to his disciples, "I assure you, only with difficulty will a rich man enter into the kingdom of

God. I repeat what I said: it is easier for a camel to pass through a needle's eye than for a rich man to enter the kingdom of God.” When the disciples heard this they were completely overwhelmed, and exclaimed, “Then who can be saved?” Jesus looked at them and said, “For man it is impossible; but for God all things are possible.”

Seeing the Dormition of the Most Pure One,* the angels were filled with awe at how the Virgin went from earth to heaven.* In you, O pure Virgin,* the laws of nature were overcome.* in giving birth you remained a virgin,* and in your death, heralded life.* You remained a virgin after giving birth* and remained alive after death,* always saving your descendants,* O Mother of God.

Communion Hymn: Praise the Lord from the heavens, praise Him in the highest. I will take the chalice of salvation; and I will call upon the name of the Lord. Alleluia! Alleluia! Alleluia!

Євангелія: Від Матея 19: 16 - 26

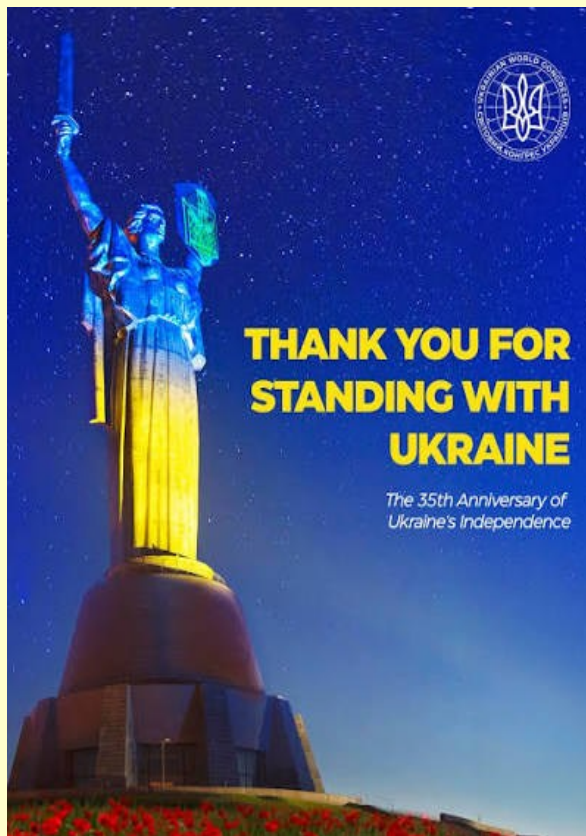

METROPOLITAN BORYS GUDZIAK AND A DELEGATION FROM THE PHILADELPHIA ARCHDIOCESE BEGIN THEIR SOLIDARITY VISIT TO UKRAINE / AUGUST 13, 2026

Metropolitan Borys Gudziak of Philadelphia has begun a pastoral solidarity visit to the eparchies of the Ukrainian Greek Catholic Church in Ukraine. He is accompanied by a small delegation: Bishop Hlib Lonchyna, Bishop Emeritus of the UGCC; Fr. Mark Fesniak, dean of the South Anthracite Deanery of the Philadelphia Archdiocese; Andrea Kochan Neagle; Gina Christian; and Sofia Zacharczuk. Metropolitan Borys explains that

the purpose of the visit is to better understand how people in Ukraine are living after nearly five years of unjust Russian aggression, to express solidarity with them, and to learn more about the charitable work of various Church structures, drawing inspiration from their resilience and dedication.

The visit began in Chernivtsi, where the delegation was welcomed by Bishop Yosafat Moshchych, Eparch of Chernivtsi, and his team, including Tetiana

Pankiv, director of Caritas of the eparchy and graduate of the St. Gabriel Institute. At the start of their time in Chernivtsi, the delegation also visited the apartment-museum of Ukrainian composer Volodymyr Ivasiuk.

Meeting at Chernivtsi National University

On August 11, the delegation visited Yuriy Fedkovych Chernivtsi National University, where they met with Rector Ruslan Biloskurskyi. Also taking part in the meeting were Iryna Osovska, vice-rector for academic and international affairs; Yuriy Khalavka, vice-rector for research; and Oksana Matiichuk, deputy head of the international relations office. Participants discussed how the educational process at Ukrainian universities has changed since the start of the full-scale invasion, drawing on the experience of Chernivtsi National University and the Ukrainian Catholic University. Particular attention was given to work with veterans and internally displaced persons. According to university leadership, this is one of the institution's priorities. The university's dormitories have housed roughly 300 internally displaced people since the start of the war, though space remains scarce, since approximately 2/3 of the student body comes from outside Chernivtsi. One question participants raised was how to keep young people in Ukraine, and how to help them see a future here. A separate conversation focused on the formation of theology students. Rector Biloskurskyi noted that student life at the university extends well beyond academics: students organize their own initiatives, including charity fundraisers. The university runs a Veterans Development Center, which supports veterans' social reintegration, including those who have returned with amputations. Much of that work happens through the arts — exhibitions, theater, workshops. As university staff put it, this isn't a separate strategy but a daily practice. A hundred university employees are currently serving in the war; an online Book of Memory honors those who have died in service.

Caritas of the Chernivtsi Eparchy

The delegation visited the Inclusive Café run by Caritas of the Chernivtsi Eparchy, a social enterprise supported in part by the Philadelphia Metropolia's Healing of the Wounds of War in Ukraine Fund. Guests met the young people with disabilities who work there: barista Yaroslav and volunteer Liza, who assists him.

Bishop Hlib Lonchyna led a Divine Liturgy at the Chapel in the Caritas Office. The delegation also met with the Caritas team, who spoke not only about the organization's projects and initiatives but about their own experiences of the war — among the staff are internally displaced people and those who have lost family members.

The first day of the solidarity tour ended with a visit to the eparchy's "Eco-Farm". The delegation visited the "Kozyni Dvir" (Goat Yard) outside Chernivtsi, a social enterprise of the Chernivtsi Eparchy that produces craft cheeses from goat's and cow's milk and also serves as a venue for eparchial events, including a children's camp which was on-going. On August 12, Metropolitan Borys led a Hierarchical Divine Liturgy at the Cathedral

of the Dormition of the Blessed Virgin Mary in Chernivtsi.

Medical University

The delegation visited Bukovinian State Medical University, where they were welcomed by Volodymyr Khodorovskiy, vice-rector for academic affairs, and Oksana Hodovanets, vice-rector for academic affairs and international relations. They toured the university's simulation center, seeing its practice-based approach to medical education: training on mannequins built to closely replicate real clinical situations, including simulators for dental students. The bishops were shown, and had explained to them, how to properly apply a tourniquet.

The solidarity visit will continue through August 15, with the delegation set to visit eparchies and Church structures in Kamianets-Podilskyi, Khmelnytskyi, Ostroh, and Lutsk.

HEAD OF THE UKRAINIAN GREEK CATHOLIC CHURCH IN WEEK 234: THEY WANT TO INSTILL IN UKRAINIANS THE TEMPTATION THAT A HORRIBLE END IS BETTER THAN ENDLESS HORROR

We must once again find the strength to resist not only the military attacks on Ukraine, but also the information attacks aimed at our souls and hearts. ARCHEPARCHY INITIATIVE: FUNDING A SEMI TRUCK OF FOOD AND RELIEF FOR DIS- PLACED FAMILIES IN KHARKIV

The Archeparchy of Winnipeg is launching a special appeal to provide immediate humanitarian relief to internally displaced people (IDPs) affected by the war in Ukraine.

During a personal visit to Kharkiv from July 19–21, I met with Bishop Vasyl Tuchapets, exarch (bishop) of Kharkiv, and dedicated volunteers who work tirelessly to distribute emergency aid to displaced families. Seeing their efforts firsthand highlighted just how immense and urgent the need is—especially with winter approaching soon.

In the Kharkiv region, over 520,000 people have been forced from their homes due to the war—with over 200,000 displaced individuals in the city of Kharkiv alone. As families continue to arrive daily from dangerous frontline villages and towns, basic survival items remain in critical demand.

Every Thursday, between 1,500 and 2,000 people gather at St. Nicholas Ukrainian Catholic Cathedral in Kharkiv seeking assistance, particularly food, medicine, clothing, shoes, and other basic necessities.

Our Goal & The Plan

We are raising \$30,000 to fund a full semi truck load (several tons) of essential supplies, including bulk food items, baby food, and other basic necessities. (Nota Bene: If we raise enough for two or three trucks, we will buy more supplies.)

Parish Collections: Special collections will be taken across all Archeparchy parishes through Sunday, September 27.

Direct Impact: In October, 100% of the funds will be transferred via CNEWA (Catholic Near East Welfare Association) directly to Bishop Vasyl Tuchapets in Kharkiv, who will purchase the necessary food and supplies locally.

Long-Term Relief: Purchasing these supplies directly in Ukraine avoids shipping delays and will provide enough provisions to sustain thousands of displaced individuals at the Cathedral for 4 to 5 months.

АРХИЄПАРХІАЛЬНИЙ ПРОЕКТ: ФІНАНСУВАННЯ ФУРИ З ПРОДУКТАМИ ТА ГУМАНІТАРНОЮ ДОПОМОГОЮ ДЛЯ ВНУТРІШНЬО-ПЕРЕМІЩЕНИХ ОСІБ У ХАРКОВІ

Вінніпезька Архiepapxія розпочинає спеціальну акцію для надання невідкладної гуманітарної допомоги внутрішньо переміщеним особам (ВПО), які постраждали від війни в Україні. Під час особистого візиту до Харкова 19–21 липня я зустрівся із Владиком Василем Тучапцем, екзархом Харківським, та невтомними волонтерами, які постійно працюють, роздаючи екстрену допомогу родинам переселенців. Побачивши їхні зусилля на власні очі, я ще

глибше усвідомив, наскільки величезною та нагальною є ця потреба — особливо з наближенням зими.

У Харківській області понад 520 000 людей були змушені залишити свої домівки через війну, з яких понад 200 000 перебувають у самому Харкові. Оскільки родини щодня продовжують прибувати з небезпечних прифронтових сіл і містечок, речі першої потреби залишаються критично необхідними.

Щочетверга від 1 500 до 2 000 людей збираються біля Катедрального собору Святого Миколая УГКЦ у Харкові в пошуках допомоги — зокрема продуктів харчування, ліків, одягу, взуття, тощо.

Наша мета та план дій

Ми збираємо \$30 000, щоб профінансувати цілу фуру (кілька тонн) найнеобхіднішого: продуктів харчування тривалого зберігання, дитячого харчування та інших речей першої потреби. (Примітка: якщо назбираємо достатньо на дві-три фури, ми закупимо більше).

Парафіяльні збори: Спеціальна збірка проводитиметься в усіх парафіях Архiepapxії до неділі, 27 вересня.

Пряма допомога: У жовтні 100% зібраних коштів буде перераховано через CNEWA (Близькосхідну католицьку благодійну асоціацію) безпосередньо владиці Василю Тучапцю в Харків, який закупить необхідні продукти та речі на місці.

Довгострокова підтримка: Закупівля необхідного безпосередньо в Україні дозволяє уникнути затримок із доставкою та забезпечить тисячі переселенців при соборі всім необхідним на 4–5 місяців.

“THE MOUNTAIN IS A PLACE WHERE PEOPLE ESPECIALLY COME TO EXPERIENCE GOD’S PRESENCE” — HIS BEATITUDE SVIATOSLAV ON MOUNT PIP IVAN (AUGUST 5, 2026)
“A mountain always helps a person lift their eyes to God. Here, the silence in which the Lord speaks to the human heart is especially tangible.” His Beatitude Sviatoslav, Father and Head of the Ukrainian Greek Catholic Church, shared these words during his stay on Mount Pip Ivan in the Chornohora range. This trip took place at the invitation of Valentyna Yakubiv, rector of the Vasyl Stefanyk Precarpathian National University.

His Beatitude Sviatoslav was joined by Metropolitan Volodymyr Vityshyn of Ivano-Frankivsk, Auxiliary Bishop Mykola Semenyshyn of the Ivano-Frankivsk Archeparchy, University Rector Valentyna Yakubiv, and former Rector and current Chair of the Academic Council Ihor Tsependa as they climbed one of the highest peaks of the Ukrainian Carpathians.

While at the summit, the participants prayed for Ukraine, for peace and victory for our nation, for the healing of the wounds of war among our people, for the families of Ukrainian servicemen, and for the families of Ukraine’s fallen and missing defenders.

This trip was a continuation of His Beatitude Sviatoslav’s meeting with students of the Precarpathian National University, which took place this past spring. During that visit, the students invited the Father and Head of the Ukrainian Greek Catholic Church to explore Mount Pip Ivan and the legendary “White Elephant” high-altitude observatory

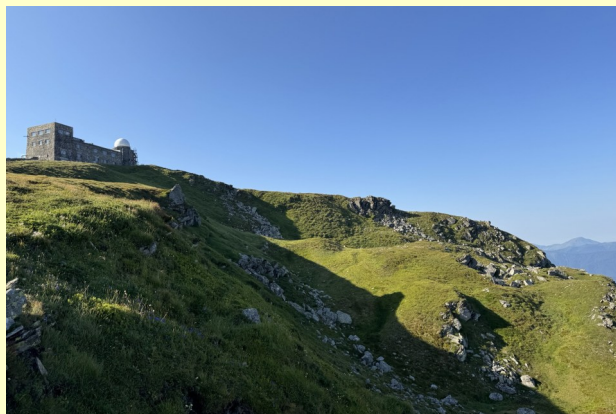
As His Beatitude Sviatoslav has repeatedly emphasized, the mountains teach us silence, humility, and the ability to view life from God’s perspective. Every step upward reminds us that spiritual growth also requires perseverance, trust, and constant progress.

“When a person steps away from the bustle of daily life and finds themselves amidst God’s creation, they discover themselves, their neighbor, and the Lord in a newfound way. That is precisely why the mountains become, for many, a space for prayer, gratitude, and inner renewal,” emphasized the Head of the UGCC, reflecting on the significance of the Carpathians in human life.

After the hike, the participants visited the “White Elephant” high-altitude observatory, which has become one of the symbols of the Chornohora range and a place where science, history, and respect for God’s creation meet.

Mount Pip Ivan is one of the highest peaks in the Ukrainian Carpathians (2,028.5 m), located on the Chornohora Range on the border between Ivano-Frankivsk and Zakarpattia Oblasts. Its summit is the site of the “White Elephant” high-altitude observatory, built in 1938, which is one of the most famous historic and tourist attractions in the Carpathians.

Basic Guidelines for Reception of Holy Communion

You are a member of the Catholic Church; You have participated in the Sacrament of Confession at least during the Easter or Christmas seasons this past year if not more frequently;

You attend Divine Services regularly; Your lifestyle is consistent with the teaching of the Catholic Church; You have kept the Liturgical fast – no food at least one hour prior to the Divine Liturgy (water and medicine does not break the fast). You have been in church from the beginning of the service, or at least heard the Gospel. To the best of your ability, you are in the state of Grace. ***If for any of these or other reasons you cannot receive Holy Communion, you are welcome to come for a blessing. Please indicate to the priest that you would like to receive his blessing. For those who are divorced and living common-law the Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist cannot be received. You are welcome to come for a blessing. (If you are divorced with a Church annulment, and remarried in the Church you are more than welcome to receive the Holy Sacraments.)***
