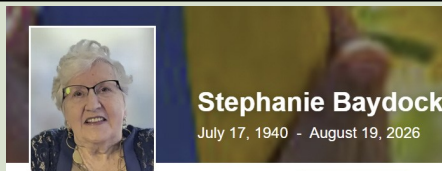

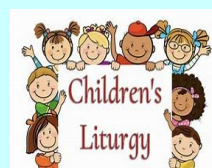

Tropar, tone 5: Let us the faithful acclaim and worship the Word, co-eternal with the Father and the Spirit, and born of the Virgin for our salvation. For He willed to be lifted up on the cross in the flesh,* to suffer death and to raise the dead by His glorious resurrection.

Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, now and for ever and ever. Amen.

Kondak, tone 5: You, my Savior, descended to Hades, and as the Almighty, You shattered its gates. With Yourself You, as the Creator, raised the dead and shattered the sting of death, and delivered Adam from the curse, O Lover of Mankind. And so we cry out: "Save us, O Lord."

Prokimen, tone 5: You, O Lord, will guard us and will keep us from this generation, and for ever.

Verse: Save me, O Lord, for there is no longer left a just man.

Epistle: A reading from the Second Letter of the Holy Apostle Paul to the Corinthians. (1: 21 - 2: 4) Brothers and Sisters! God is the one who firmly establishes us along with you in Christ; it is he who anointed us and has sealed us, thereby depositing the first payment, the Spirit, in our hearts. I call on God as my witness that it was out of consideration for you that I did not come to Corinth again. Domineering over your faith is not my purpose. I prefer to work with you toward your happiness. As regards faith, you are standing firm. I did decide, however, not to visit you again in painful circumstances. For if I cause you pain, who can make me happy again but the ones I grieved? I wrote as I did so that when I come I may not be saddened by those who should rejoice my heart. I know you all well enough to be convinced that my happiness is yours. That is why I wrote you in great sorrow and anguish, with copious tears -- not to make you sad but to help you realize the great love I bear you.

Alleluia Verses: Your mercies, O Lord, I will sing for ever; from generation to generation I will announce Your truth with my mouth. For You have said: Mercy shall be built up for ever; in the heavens Your truth shall be prepared.

Gospel: Matthew 22: 1 - 14

The Lord told this parable: "The reign of God may be likened to a king who gave a wedding banquet for his son. He dispatched his servants to summon the invited guests to the wedding, but they refused to come. A second time he sent other servants, saying: 'Tell those who were invited, See, I have my dinner prepared! My bullocks and corn-fed cattle are killed; everything is ready. Come to the feast.' Some ignored the invitation and went their way, one to his farm, another to his business. The rest laid hold of his servants, insulted them, and killed them. At this the king grew furious and sent his army to destroy those murderers and burn their city. Then he said to his servants: 'The banquet is ready, but those who were invited were unfit to come. That is why you must go out into the byroads and invite to the wedding anyone you come upon.' The servants then went out into the byroads and rounded up everyone they met, bad as well as good. This filled the wedding hall with banqueters. When the king came in to meet the guests, however, he caught sight of a man not properly dressed for a wedding feast. 'My friend,' he said, 'how is it you came in here not properly dressed?' The man had nothing to say. The king then said to the attendants, 'Bind him hand and foot and throw him out into the night to wail and grind his teeth.' The invited are many, the elect are few.

Браття і Сестри! Той, хто утверджує нас з вами во Христі і хто помазав нас, то Бог, який поклав на нас свою печать і дав у наші серця завдаток Духа. А я прикликаю свідком Бога на мою душу, що я щадивши вас, не прийшов більше в Корінт. Не начебто ми панували над вашою вірою, але ми хочемо співпрацювати -- вам на радість; бо ви щодо віри стоїте міцно. Я постановив собі не приходити до вас знов у смутку; бо коли я вам завдаю смутку, то хто мене розвеселить, як не той, що зазнає від мене смутку? Тож, написав я те, щоб, прийшовши, не мати смутку від тих, від яких мені належалася б радість, бо я відносно вас певний, що моя радість -- радість усіх вас. З великого бо горя та туги серця написав я вам і крізь ревні сльози -- не щоб ви сумували, а щоб знали мою надмірну до вас любов.

Євангелія: Від Матея 22: 1 - 14 Сказав Господь притчу оцю: "Царство Небесне схоже на царя, що справив своєму синові весілля. Він послав своїх слуг кликати запрошених на весілля, але вони не хотіли прийти. Тоді він знову послав інших слуг, кажучи: 'Скажіть запрошеним: Ось я зготував обід мій; зарізано волів та годовану худобу, все готове, ідіть на весілля.' Та вони ним знехтували і пішли геть, хто на власне поле, хто до свого крамарства; інші ж, схопивши слуг, знущалися з них і вбили. Розгнівався цар і вислав військо, яке вигубило тих убивців, а їхнє місто спалило. Тоді він мовив своїм слугам: 'Обід готовий, але запрошені були негідні. Підіть, отже, на роздоріжжя і, кого лише здибаєте, кличте на весілля.' Вийшли ці слуги на дороги і зібрали всіх, кого тільки спіткали, і злих і добрих, так що весільна світлиця була повна гостей. Якже ввійшов цар, щоб подивитися на гостей, побачив там чоловіка, що не був убраний у весільну одіж, і сказав до нього: 'Як ти ввійшов сюди, друже, не маючи весільної одежі?' Той мовчав. Тоді цар промовив до слуг: 'Зв'яжіть йому ноги й руки і киньте геть у темряву кромішню. Там буде плач і скрегіт зубів.' Багато бо покликаних, але мало вибраних."

The Beheading of St. John the Baptist

August 29, 2026

"In addition to the feast of the Nativity of St. John the Baptist on June 24, the church, since the fourth century has commemorated the martyrdom of Christ's Forerunner. The story of the saint's death is among the most dramatic narratives in Holy Scripture. All three synoptic writers refer to it. St. Mark goes into the greatest detail (Mk. 6:14-29). Matthew provides the text from which the Gospel of the feast is taken (Mt. 14:1-12); St. Luke is the briefest (Lk. 3:19-29, 9:7-9).

The story of St. John's beheading is basically as follows. *Herod Antipas fell in love with Herodias, the wife of his brother Philip, and took her for his wife, thus breaking the Jewish law against levirate marriage.* John the Baptist fearlessly reprimanded the king for his adulterous union, saying, "It is not lawful for you to have your brother's wife" (Mk. 6:18). Herod was at first afraid to harm the great prophet; but later, at the instigation of Herodias, he imprisoned him in the fortress of Machaerus. But Herod had not yet made an ultimate decision. He wavered in his resolve and at times even wanted to release John." *But Herodias laid snares for him, and would have liked to put him to death" (Mk. 6:19).* Her chance came at the birthday feast, which Herod gave for the "princess and tribunes, and chief men of Galilee. And Herodias' own daughter having come in and danced, pleased Herod and his guest. And the King said to the girl, Ask of me what you will, and I will give it to you.' And he swore to her, 'Whatever you ask, I will give you even though it be the half of my kingdom'" (Mk 6:21-23). ***Advised by her revengeful mother, she asked for the head of John the Baptist. Herod had not anticipated such a request. The Gospel says, "He was struck sad." But nonetheless, he complied with it "because of his oath and his guest."*** He sent the executioner to the prison to behead the man of God. The Gospel tells nothing further about the abasement of the holy head, but legend states that the adulteress was bent on keeping in her possession the tongue of him who did not spare her guilt.

The liturgy describes this tragic end of the Forerunner. St. John Damascene in his sticheras tells in brief the story of the feast: ***"As the birthday of the impudent Herod was being kept, the object of the dissolute dancer's oath was achieved: first, the head of the Forerunner was cut off and offered on a platter as food for those reclining. What Loathsome banquet, replete with wickedness and horrible murder!"***

[...] There are actually three separate findings of the head of St. John recorded in various traditions, and each of these is commemorated in the Byzantine rite by a special holy day: On ***May 24*** we celebrate the first and second findings, and the third finding is commemorated. These precious relics were lost more times. ***Apart from the Mother of God, there is no saint who is honoured by more feasts than St. John the Baptist.*** The fast is prescribed on this day."

Glory be to Jesus Christ! Glory be forever!

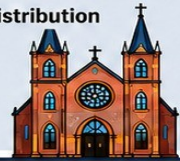

Basic Guidelines for Reception of Holy Communion

You are a member of the Catholic Church; You have participated in the Sacrament of Confession at least during the Easter or Christmas seasons this past year if not more frequently;

You attend Divine Services regularly; Your lifestyle is consistent with the teaching of the Catholic Church; You have kept the Liturgical fast – no food at least one hour prior to the Divine Liturgy (water and medicine does not break the fast). You have been in church from the beginning of the service, or at least heard the Gospel. To the best of your ability, you are in the state of Grace. ***If for any of these or other reasons you cannot receive Holy Communion, you are welcome to come for a blessing. Please indicate to the priest that you would like to receive his blessing.*** For those who are divorced and living common-law the Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist cannot be received. You are welcome to come for a blessing. (If you are divorced with a Church annulment, and remarried in the Church you are more than welcome to receive the Holy Sacraments.)
