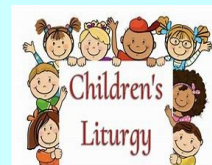

Sunday Tropar, tone 8: You came down from on high, O Merciful One,* and accepted three days of burial* to free us from our sufferings.* O Lord, our life and our resurrection,* glory be to You.

Tropar of the Exaltation, tone 1: Save Your people, O Lord, and bless Your inheritance.* Grant victory to Your faithful people against enemies,* and protect Your community by Your cross.

Glory be to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit, now and forever and ever. Amen.

Sunday Kondak, tone 8: When You rose from the tomb,* You also raised the dead and resurrected Adam.* Eve exults in Your resurrection,* and the ends of the world celebrate Your rising from the dead,* O most merciful One.

To Your cross, O Master, we bow in veneration, and we glorify Your holy Resurrection.

Prokimen, tone 8: Pray and give praise to the Lord our God.

Verse: In Judea God is known; His name is great in Israel.

Epistle: A reading from the Letter of the Holy Apostle Paul to the Galatians. (2: 16 - 20)

Brothers and Sisters! Knowing that a man is not justified by legal observance but by faith in Jesus Christ, we too have believed in him in order to be justified by faith in Christ, not by observance of the law; for by works of the law no one will be justified. But if, in seeking to be justified in Christ, we are shown to be sinners does that mean that Christ is encouraging sin? Unthinkable! If, however, I were to build up the very things I had demolished, I should then indeed be a transgressor. It was through the law that I died to the law, to live for God. I have been crucified with Christ, and the life I live now is not my own; Christ is living in me. I still live my human life, but it is a life of faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.

Alleluia Verses: Come, let us rejoice in the Lord; let us acclaim God our Savior.

Let us come before His countenance with praise and acclaim Him with psalms.

Gospel: Mark 8:34 - 9:1

At that time He summoned the crowd with his disciples and said to them: "If a man wishes to come after me, he must deny his very self, take up his cross, and follow in my steps. Whoever would preserve his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for my sake and gospel's will preserve it. What profit does a man show who gains the whole world and destroys himself in the process? What can a man offer in exchange for his life! If anyone in this faithless and corrupt age is ashamed of me and my doctrine, the Son of Man will be ashamed of him when he comes with the holy angels in his Father's glory." He also said to them: "I assure you, among those standing here there are some who will not taste death until they see the reign of God established in power."

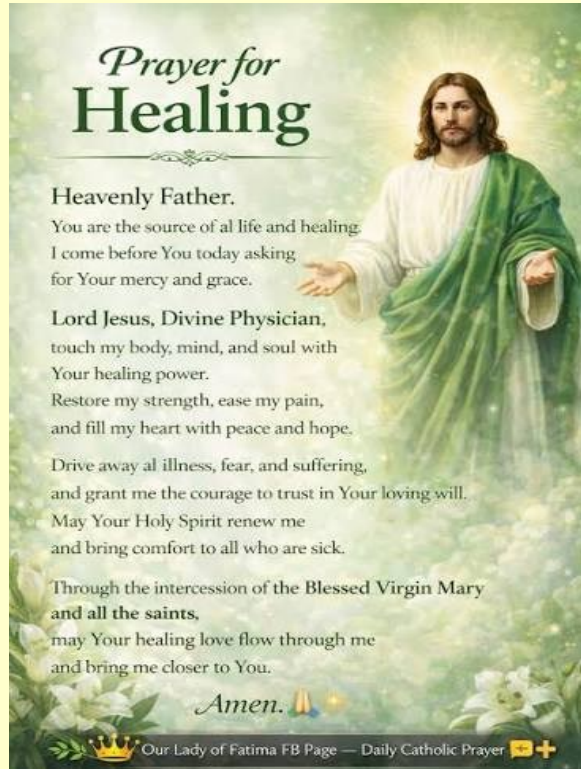

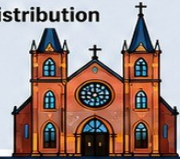

THE HEAD OF THE UKRAINIAN GREEK CATH- OLIC CHURCH IN WEEK 239 OF THE WAR: SURVIVING THIS WINTER MEANS PREPARING FOR IT TOGETHER

Our resilience this winter will stem from our local resilience. How well Ukraine endures the cold season will depend on how well we prepare our homes for winter now. His Beatitude Sviatoslav, Father and Head of the Ukrainian Greek Catholic Church, made this statement in his

traditional video address marking the 239th week of Russia's full-scale invasion of Ukrainian territory.

This week has been very difficult for Ukraine. Russia is escalating its attacks—particularly its airstrikes—on our cities and villages...

The Primate noted: "It is telling that the main targets of the Russian strikes were high-rise buildings. The Russians focused particularly on schools, hospitals, and warehouses—especially those storing food, medicine, and other essentials needed to sustain life in major cities. Energy infrastructure was also hit."

"So," the Head of the Church concluded, "the Russians are deliberately and systematically destroying the utility and energy infrastructure of our cities and villages, with the specific aim of turning these towns into ghost towns, particularly this winter."

That is why, today, responsible preparation for winter means collective resilience and victory.

"In the context of the systematic destruction of our cities' centralized utilities—water, electricity, and heat—we must make every effort to prepare for this winter. To survive this winter means preparing for it together. Therefore, preparing does not mean giving in to panic, but using the autumn God has granted us responsibly and rationally," His Beatitude Sviatoslav asserted.

The spiritual leader called on all parishes, monasteries, and communities to become centers of energy resilience for our people:

"We must focus not so much on caring for ourselves as on doing everything we can to open our doors this winter to those who will suffer from darkness, cold, and water shortages. Today, the Church's ministry means becoming hubs—centers of resilience—for our cities and villages throughout this autumn and winter."

Address by the Head of the UGCC for the 239th Week of the Full-Scale War, September 13, 2026

The Head of the Church made a special appeal to our friends and international partners to help Ukraine develop local energy resilience.

"We know that the enemy's plans to freeze Ukraine and plunge us into darkness and cold will not succeed. Together we will get through this winter; together we will bring warmth and light to all those who need our Christian love, solidarity, and witness," said the spiritual leader of the Ukrainian people.

Pope Leo XIV Blesses Participants in the UGCC Youth Ministry Forum in Europe

On September 9, at the Vatican, following the General Audience, participants in the Forum on Youth Ministry of the Ukrainian Greek Catholic Church in Europe met with Pope Leo XIV. Representatives of Ukrainian youth

communities asked the Holy Father to pray for peace in Ukraine and presented him with a vyshyvanka featuring an image of all the regions of Ukraine, as well

as a book entitled *The Eyes of War*.

Vatican News and DyvenSvit reported on the meeting. After a joint prayer, the Pope blessed those present. The forum participants also had the opportunity to take a group photo with the Holy Father.

The gifts were presented to the Pope by Bishop Bryan Bayda, chairman of the UGCC Patriarchal Commission on Youth Affairs, and his deputy, Fr. Roman Demush. The vyshyvanka featuring images of all the regions of Ukraine has become a symbol of the unity of the country and its people. The book *Eyes of War* by Ukrainian photographers Kostyantyn and Vlada Liberovy, presented with the authors' autographs, contains 280 photographs taken between 2022 and 2025 and bears witness to the reality of the war in Ukraine. According to Fr. Roman Demush, the forum participants had been preparing for the meeting for quite some time. It was important for them to tell the Holy Father about Ukrainian young people who, because of the war, have been scattered across various European countries, and to ask for his prayers for peace. The priest noted that the meeting was a sign of the closeness and solidarity of the Universal Church with young Ukrainians who have been forced to leave their homes.

"Ukraine, its youth, and its suffering are seen and heard," Fr. Roman emphasized.

Reflecting on the meeting in light of the theme of human dignity raised by the Pope during the General Audience, the priest said that Ukrainian youth, who bear the burden of war, are defending the sovereignty and territorial integrity of the state, as well as human life and the dignity of every person. A Roadmap for the Pastoral Care of Youth in the Ukrainian Greek Catholic Church in Europe Is Being Developed in Rome. The Forum on Youth Ministry of the Ukrainian Greek Catholic Church in Europe will take place from September 8 to 10 at the Pontifical Ukrainian College of St. Josaphat in Rome. It has brought together more than fifty representatives involved in youth ministry from various European countries to share experiences and seek answers to the challenges of supporting Ukrainian youth abroad.

Preparing for Our Archeparchial Forum on the Family

As we prepare for the upcoming **Forum on the Family in our Archeparchy of Winnipeg**, we are invited to reflect more deeply on the message of the 2025 Synod of Bishops of the Ukrainian Greek Catholic Church, **“Persevering in Hope, Strong in Love: The Ukrainian Family in Time of War.”**

The Synod reminds us that the Christian family is much more than simply a group of people living under one roof. The family is called to be a **“Domestic Church”**—the first place where children encounter God, learn to pray, experience love and forgiveness, and discover what it means to serve one another. Parents have a special vocation to become the first witnesses of God’s love and goodness to their children.



At the same time, the bishops recognize that family life today is not easy. Ukrainian families in particular continue to experience the consequences of war: separation, displacement, loss of loved ones, financial uncertainty, physical and psychological wounds, and anxiety about the future. Yet precisely in these difficult circumstances, the Christian family is called to remain **“persevering in hope and strong in love.”**

The Church also has an important responsibility. Our parishes should become places where families know that they are **welcomed, supported, heard, and accompanied**—places of prayer and the Holy Mysteries, but also places of compassion, healing, friendship, and practical support. The Synod especially encourages parishes to prepare young people and engaged couples for family life and to accompany families throughout their Christian vocation.

Our upcoming **Archeparchial Forum on the Family** therefore gives us an important opportunity to listen, reflect, and ask ourselves: *What are families experiencing today? What are their greatest challenges? What do our children and young people need from us? How can our parishes better support marriages, parents, grandparents, single-parent families, newcomers, and families experiencing suffering or loss?*

The bishops also remind us about one simple but precious gift that every family needs: **time**. Time cannot be replaced once it is gone. We are encouraged to make time for common prayer, conversation between husband and wife, loving attention to children, and care for grandparents, the elderly, the wounded, and those who are suffering.

As we prepare for this Forum, let us pray for all families in our Archeparchy and ask the Holy Spirit to show us how our parishes can become even more truly **a family of families**—places where every generation can encounter Christ and experience His love through one another.

May every family hear and experience the beautiful assurance expressed by our bishops: **“Your Church is always with you!”**

Basic Guidelines for Reception of Holy Communion

You are a member of the Catholic Church; You have participated in the Sacrament of Confession at least during the Easter or Christmas seasons this past year if not more frequently;

You attend Divine Services regularly; Your lifestyle is consistent with the teaching of the Catholic Church; You have kept the Liturgical fast – no food at least one hour prior to the Divine Liturgy (water and medicine does not break the fast). You have been in church from the beginning of the service, or at least heard the Gospel. To the best of your ability, you are in the state of Grace. ***If for any of these or other reasons you cannot receive Holy Communion, you are welcome to come for a blessing. Please indicate to the priest that you would like to receive his blessing.*** For those who are divorced and living common-law the Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist cannot be received. You are welcome to come for a blessing. (If you are divorced with a Church annulment, and remarried in the Church you are more than welcome to receive the Holy Sacraments.)
